



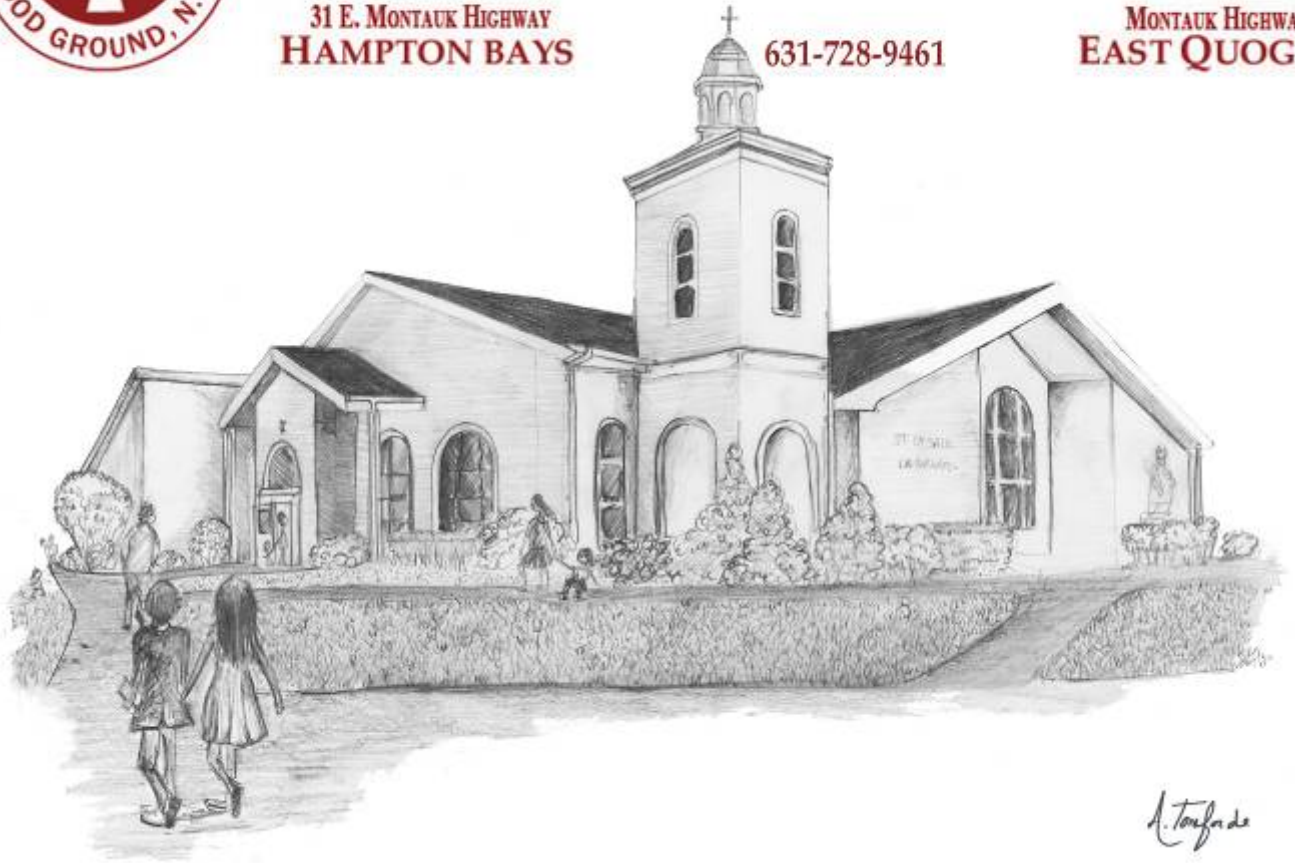

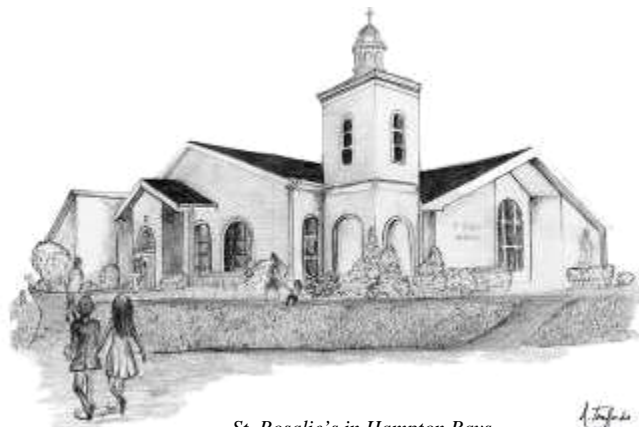

**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION**

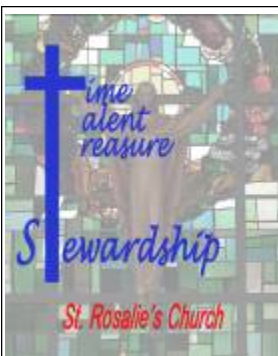
Confessions are heard on: Mondays: from 5–5:45 p.m. and Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

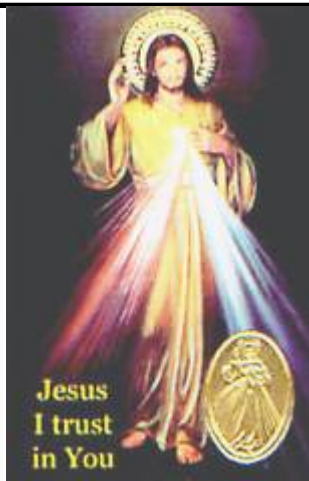

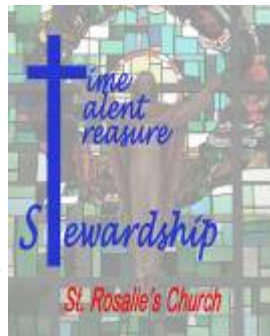
