On behalf of Centro Corazón de María and The Mexican Initiative on Deferred Action – Baruch College, City University of New York, we are delighted to invite the Latino immigrant community residing in long Island East End to our **Second Annual Latino College Fair 2019** at Hampton Bays on February 24, 2019 at the community center, Centro Corazon de Maria. The Second Annual Latino College Fair 2019 brings together educators, guidance counselors, community educational organizations, college and universities such as CUNY (City University of New York) and SUNY (State University of New York), and private educational institutions.

Stewardship Reflection

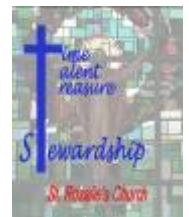
