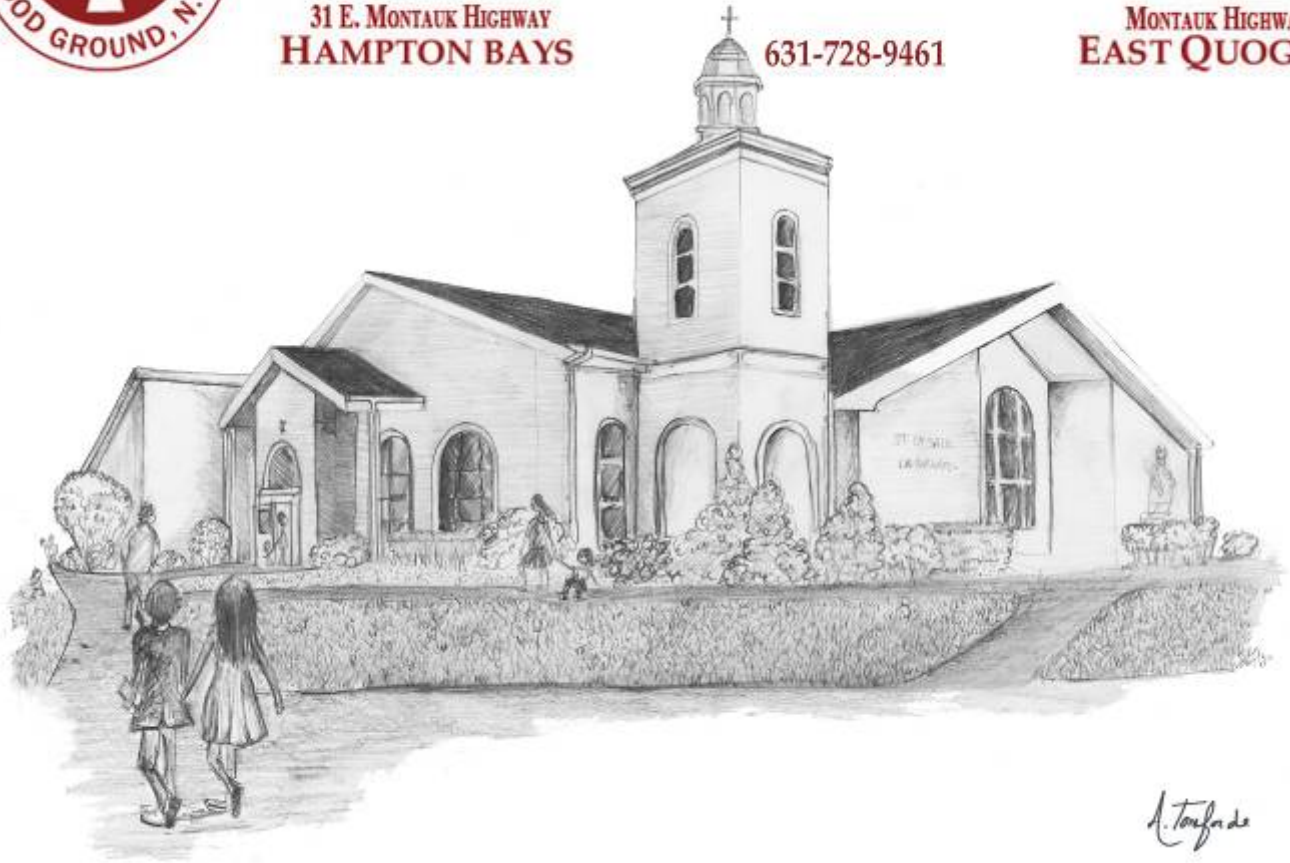

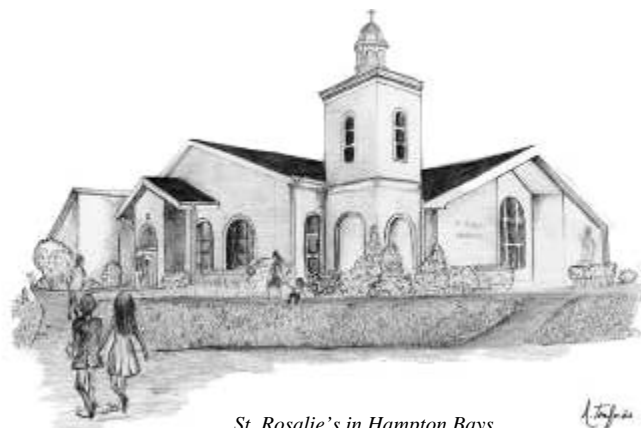

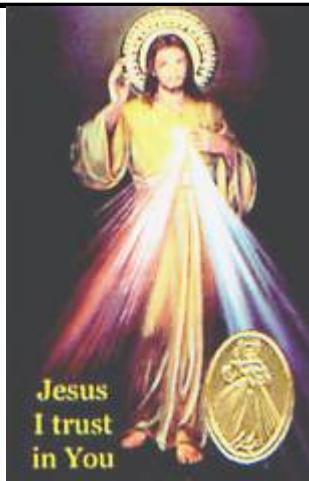

Almsgiving and mite boxes are a rich part of Catholic Lenten tradition. Many of you may remember with fondness the mite box traditions from your youth.

To encourage almsgiving as a parish community, our Committee for the Common Good will once again be handing out mite boxes after all Masses next weekend, March 2 and 3, for people who wish to donate their alms. This could be the money from treats you give up during Lent or it could be the change in your pocket emptied daily into the box. How you fill your mite box is up to you!

The mite boxes will be collected on Palm Sunday, April 14. Most of the alms money donated will go directly to our Parish Social Services Ministry which, among other things, runs the community food pantry that helps our neighbors in need. The remainder will be donated to Catholic organizations such as the Catholic Near East Welfare Association to help the victims of violence in the Middle East, many suffering as a direct result of their faith. This charity was chosen by our Religious Formation students to receive some of the funds raised by them as they recognized the plight of other children living in tents, without adequate food, without schools, without toys, without proper clothing.

We hope this Lenten season is a time when all in our community can grow in their love for the Lord and their neighbor, for it is in prayer, fasting and giving that we receive the blessings of a grateful heart. God Bless You!
