## GREEN LIGHT CAMPAIGN DRIVERS' LICENSES FOR ALL NEW YORKERS

**Centro Corazon de Maria** is part of a New York State effort to have our state senators pass a law that would grant licenses to all New Yorkers. We believe that making driver's licenses available to New Yorkers, regardless of immigration status will:

- **Make Our Roads Safer**
- **Help Our Economy**
- **Improve Equal Treatment of Immigrants**

Right now, persons who lack legal documents are not able to get driver's licenses, or car insurance in their own name. But people must drive anyway in order to get to work, pick up kids from school and get to the doctor. This situation affects the safety of all of us. In addition, it is estimated the **New York State and county governments will receive \$57 million** in combined annual revenue which will allow the expanded program to pay for itself.

**Next Sunday, March 31, we will have individual copies** of the letters addressed to our NY State Senator, Kenneth Lavallo. Anyone who wishes can sign. We will gather the letters and personally deliver them to Senator Lavallo's office.

*Called to Evangelize*

This past Tuesday was the feast day of St. Joseph, foster-father of Jesus. Despite the lack of recorded dialogue in the Gospels, St. Joseph teaches us a lot of things. Foremost, this saint simply, joyfully, wholeheartedly trusted God – in marrying Mary, in naming Jesus, in shepherding the precious pair to Egypt, in bringing them to Nazareth, in the undetermined number of years of quiet faith and courage. Do you practice such trust? You may have a satisfying job, enjoy good health and seemingly have everything under control. What happens when the storms come? Do you put your trust only in yourself? Do you escape to unhealthy activities to help ease the pain?

St. Joseph also faced huge problems but carried out his vocation with complete fidelity. He patiently taught his foster son to practice his Jewish faith, passed on its laws and customs and helped Him learn his trade. He was a *conscientious steward*...of his traditions, his vocation and his relationships.

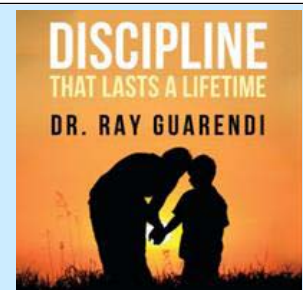
