#### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION


Confessions are heard on: Mondays: from 5–5:45 p.m. and Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.



### From the Desk of Father Maddaloni

### **ANSWERS TO COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### WHO WILL BE THE PASTOR?

As you know, I have been administrator of the parish since November 1. I am happy to tell you that on Monday, March 25, Bishop Barres told me that he has decided to appoint me pastor. That becomes official on June 26, 2019. I am very happy that he has allowed me to stay here and serve you. Let's keep praying for each other.



Yes, we will. Our previous organ stopped working reliably. After multiple attempts to fix it, it was determined that a lightning strike was a likely cause of the problem. Our music director Tom Humbert did some research, and we decided on a replacement. We entered into a contract with Allen Organ this month. Part, but not all, of the cost will be covered by insurance. We are taking this opportunity to install two speakers in the back of the church to enhance the sound. We expect the job to be complete by late spring/early summer.

#### WHAT'S HAPPENING WITH THE FLOOR AND CEILING?

The Diocese of Rockville Centre requires that for such a big repair job, architects be engaged to do diagnostic work before repairs are begun; we want to know why the floor is coming up. After receiving bids and meeting with architects, I awarded this architectural job to the firm of San Fanandre Justin Architects PC, and, in February, requested diocesan approval to proceed. I received approval in a letter dated March 19, and I signed the contract on March 25. San Fanandre Justin will begin their study this spring. I prefer not to close the church for actual repair work until after the crowded summer season, but recognize that we must work around fall weddings, confirmation and Christmas. When the church is closed, Masses will be held in the community center.

#### WHEN WILL THE NEW CHURCH DOORS COME?

Although Father Ed Sheridan ordered the doors in October before he left, there was a long delay in making them because of difficulty getting certain hardware. We now expect the doors to be here in late April.

#### HOW IS THE CHURCH IN EAST QUOGUE DOING?

The church in East Quogue has a few problems. I wanted to have the sanctuary painted before opening the church on Palm Sunday. Investigating the cause of apparent water marks on the wall, Deacon Chris Ervin and the painter discovered that the ceiling on the second floor leaked, there was mold on the upstairs walls, and there were raccoon droppings upstairs. Further investigation revealed that the flat part of the roof in the back of the church needs to be replaced. This week (the week of March 24-30), the air should be tested for safety. Early next week, repair work should begin. We hope to have the church ready for Mass on Palm Sunday. We will see how it goes.

I hope that this has been helpful. Please let me know of any other questions that may come up.






