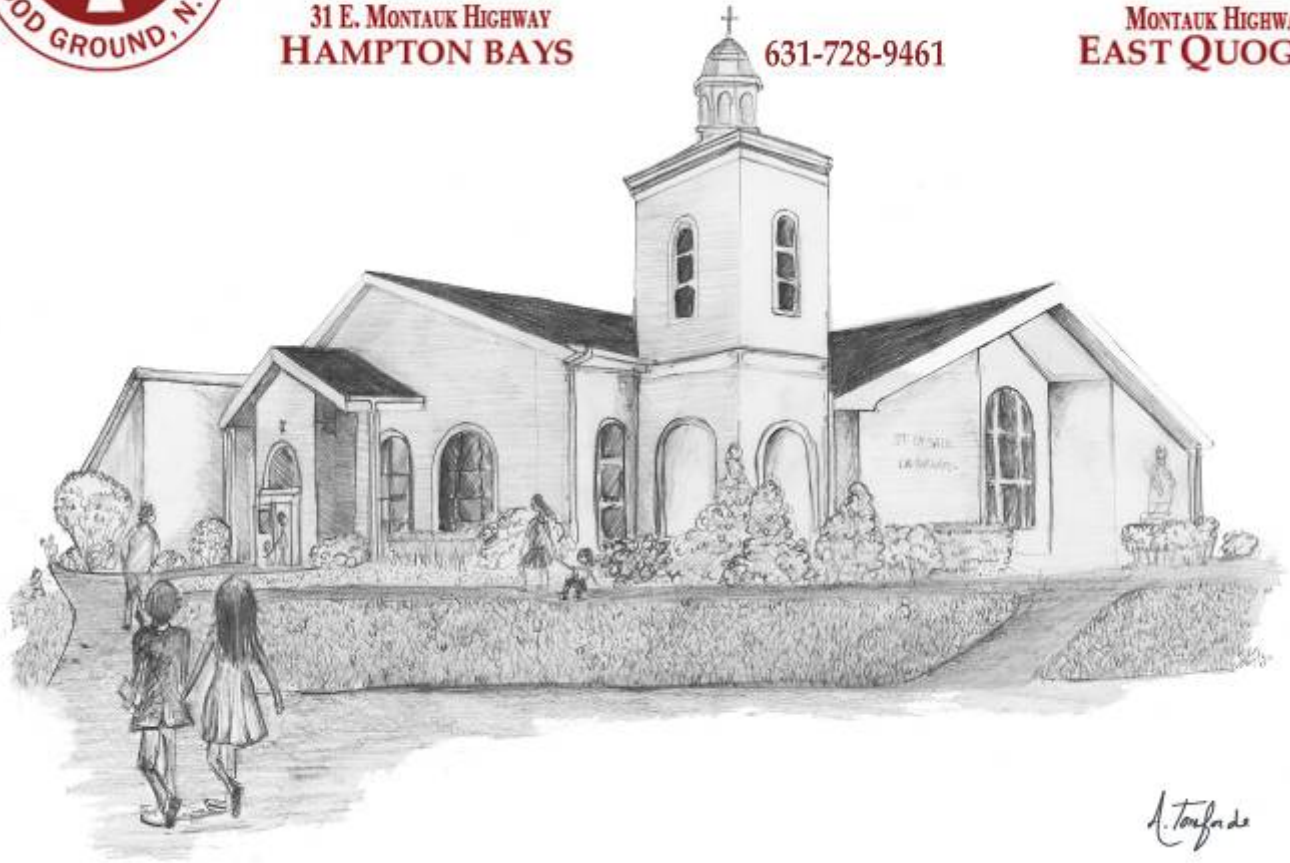

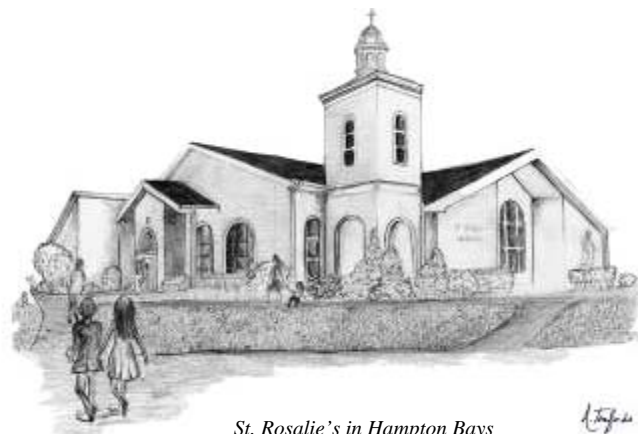

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

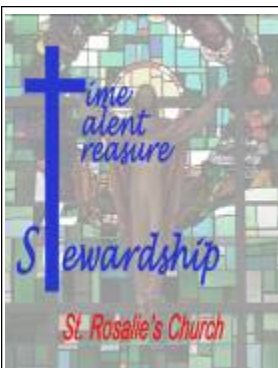
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

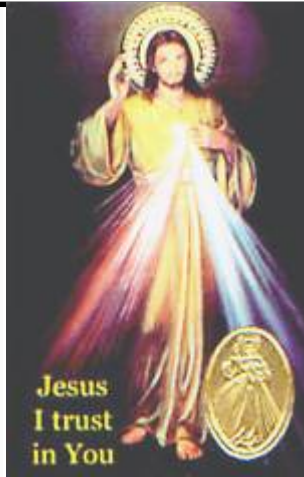

Keep in mind, we always need more catechists. Sometimes being a substitute catechist when the permanent person is not available is a life saver! Couples make great catechists and they don't always have to be at the session together. Teens are great role models as catechists, but they need an adult present in the room. All catechists must be Virtus-trained and have a discussion with Eileen McPhelin before starting this ministry. There are several opportunities to take a one-time class or several classes offered by the Diocese this summer to help those who are in this ministry or considering joining it. If the last "upgrade" of knowledge in your Catholic Faith was when you were confirmed, then you would be very surprised at how much more there is to learn. Deepening our faith comes from a better understanding of it.

In the Gospel today, Jesus says "I give you a new commandment: love one another....This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

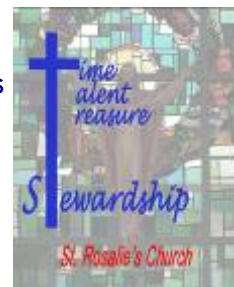
By your gift to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul you show that you have love for one another, especially those suffering and poor, and that indeed you are the disciple of Jesus.
