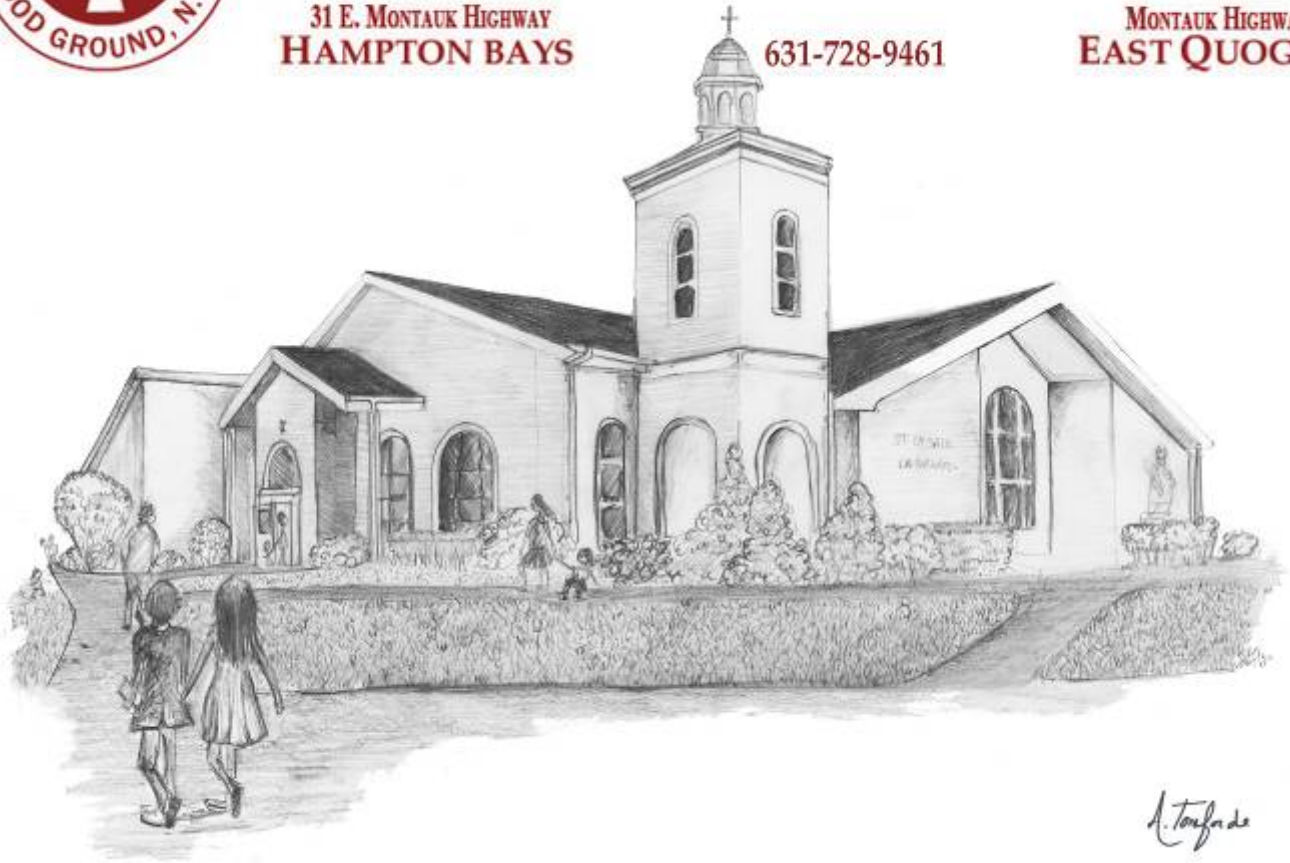

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

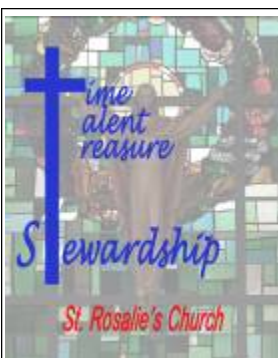
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, is Pentecost Sunday, known as the birthday of the Church. 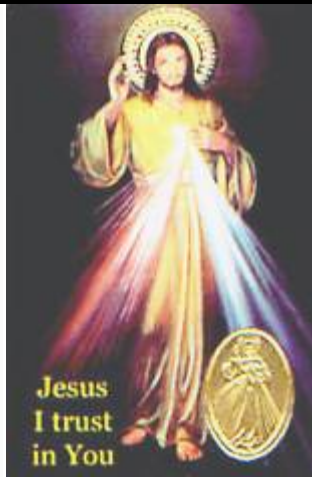
