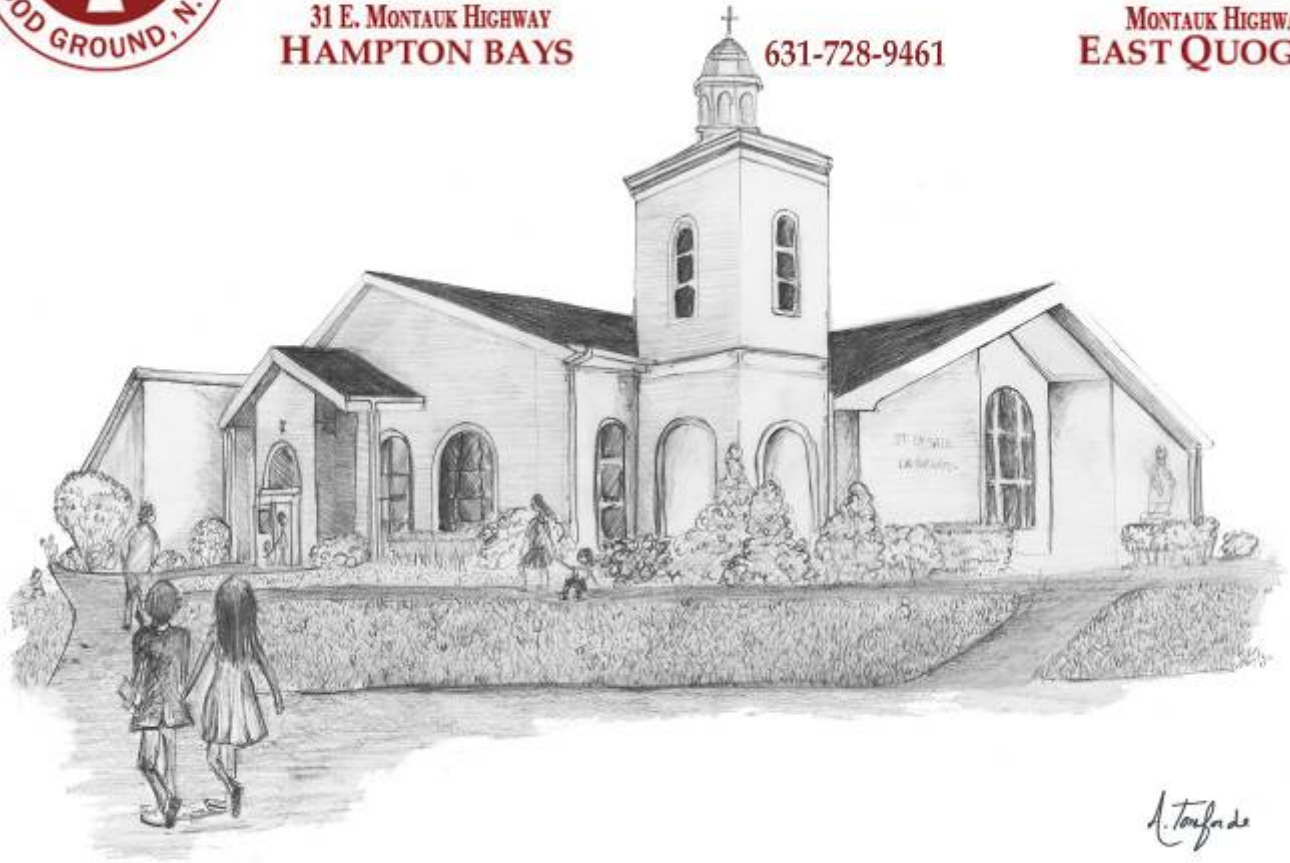

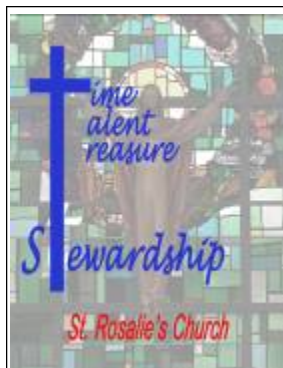

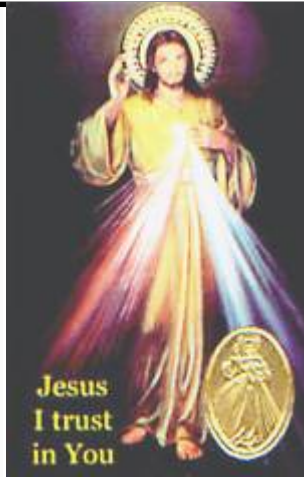

Blood Drive

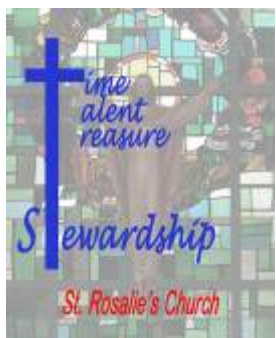
