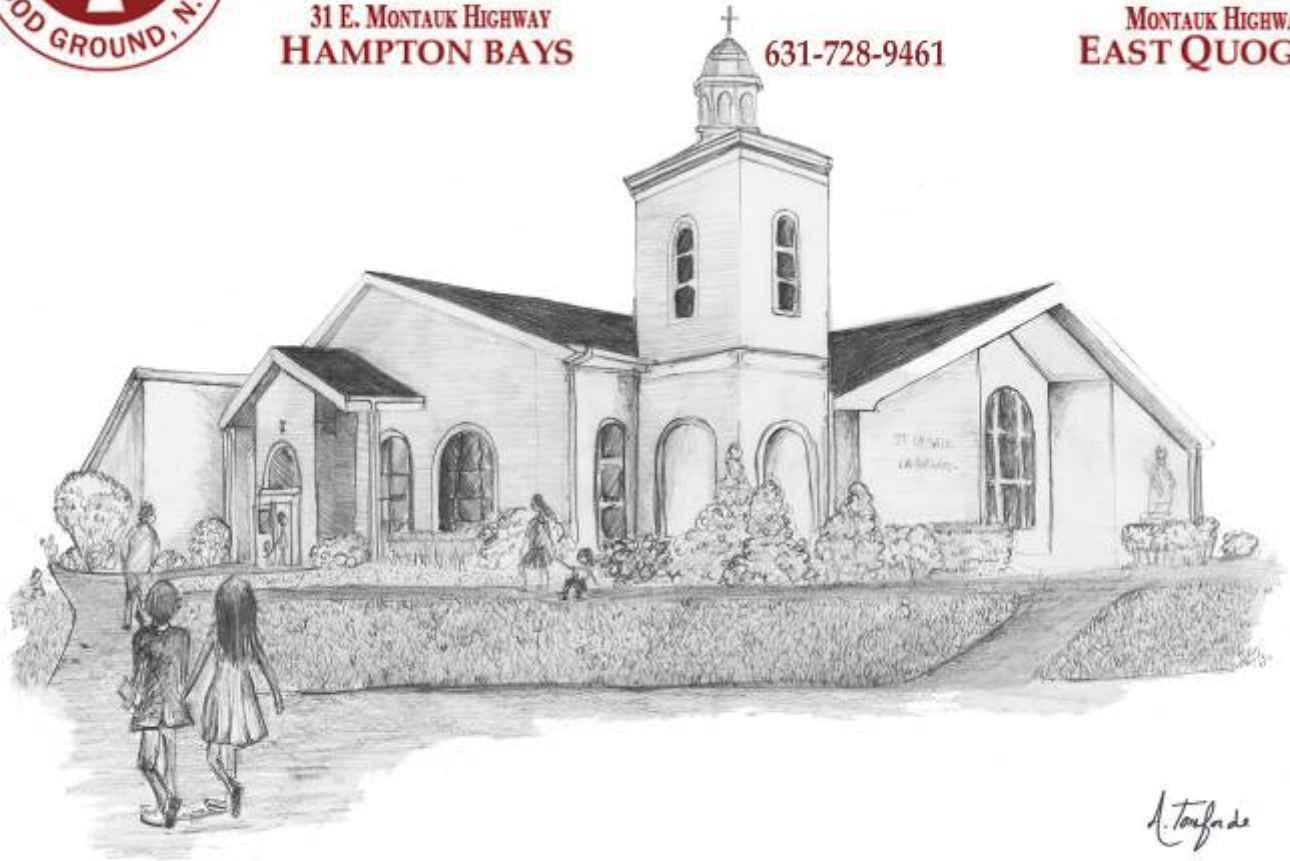

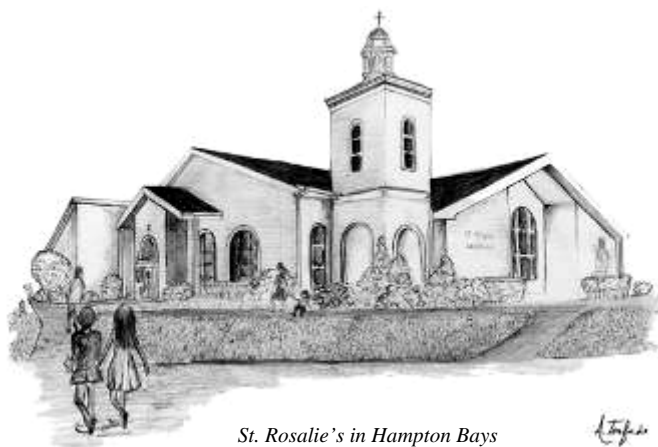

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

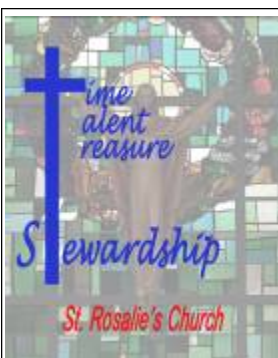
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

From The Pastor's Desk

Let us begin this column as we begin all things as Christians:

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

After all it is Trinity Sunday – this great mystery of our faith which is full of richness and love for all of us here who are part of Saint Rosalie's parish family as well as for all members of the Church – which is universal! We believe by this mystery that there is one God in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It is a mystery, we are not supposed to understand it but through the richness of practicing our faith, we become caught up in this beautiful mystery. In today's Gospel we hear the famous saying:

*God so loved the world that he gave his only Son,
so that everyone who believes in him might not perish
but might have eternal life.* JOHN 3:16

Very often at a major sporting event, at a baseball or football game for example, you might see someone holding this verse of Scripture. It is one that catches your eye. After all it is the Love of God we celebrate also today on Trinity Sunday. This Love is expressed so beautifully by the love of God the Father in sending His only Son as well as the invocation of the Holy Spirit, when Jesus Christ returns to the Father. That's what we celebrated, last Sunday on Pentecost Sunday – the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Just a thought: When we arrive for Mass in our Church it is good to keep in mind we are entering God's house. We encourage you to maintain a prayerful atmosphere in the Church in preparation for Mass. As you go outside, or in the fellowship Room, it makes sense to keep our conversations there.
