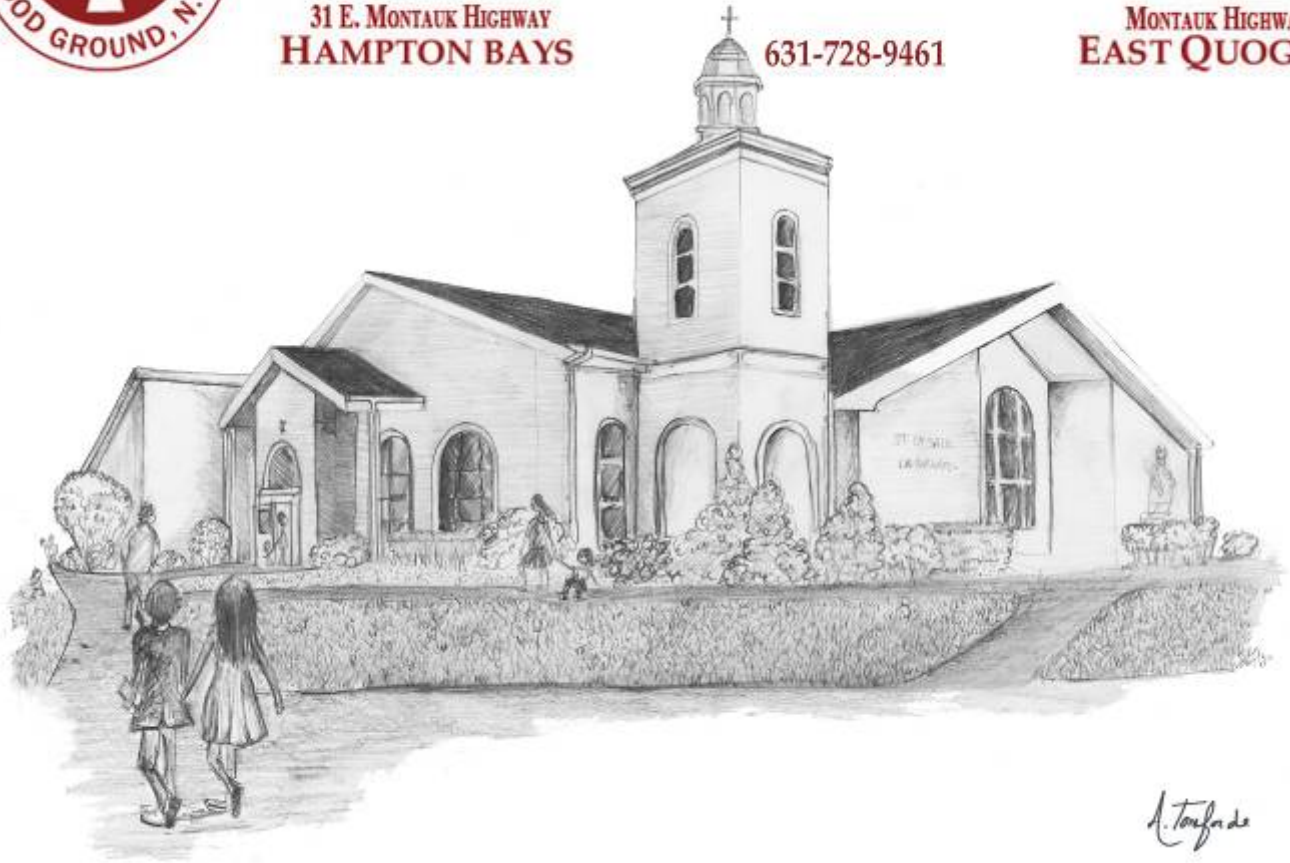

# FATHER MADDALONI'S INSTALLATION MASS

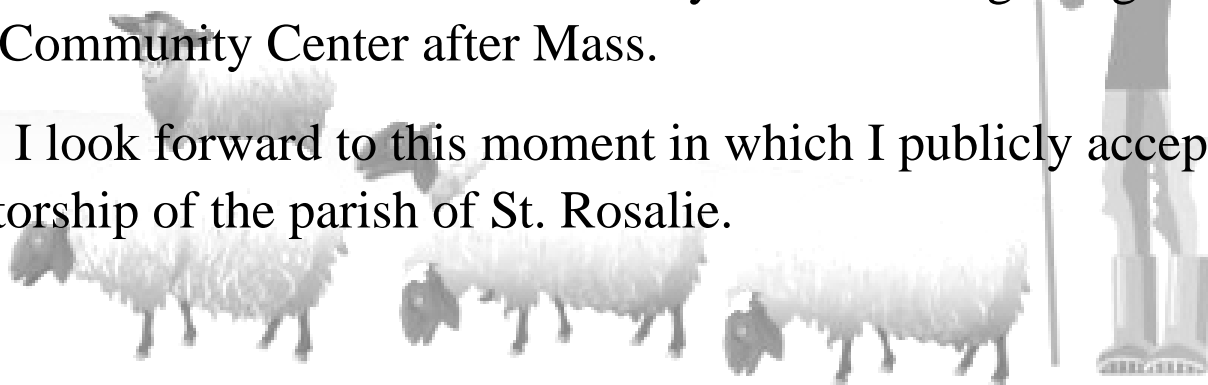

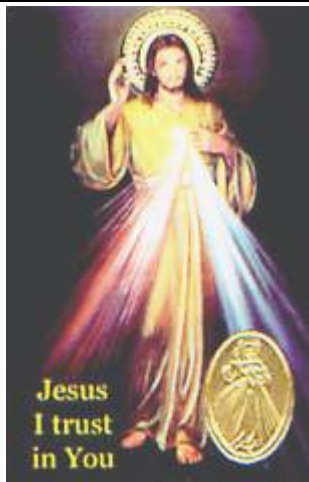

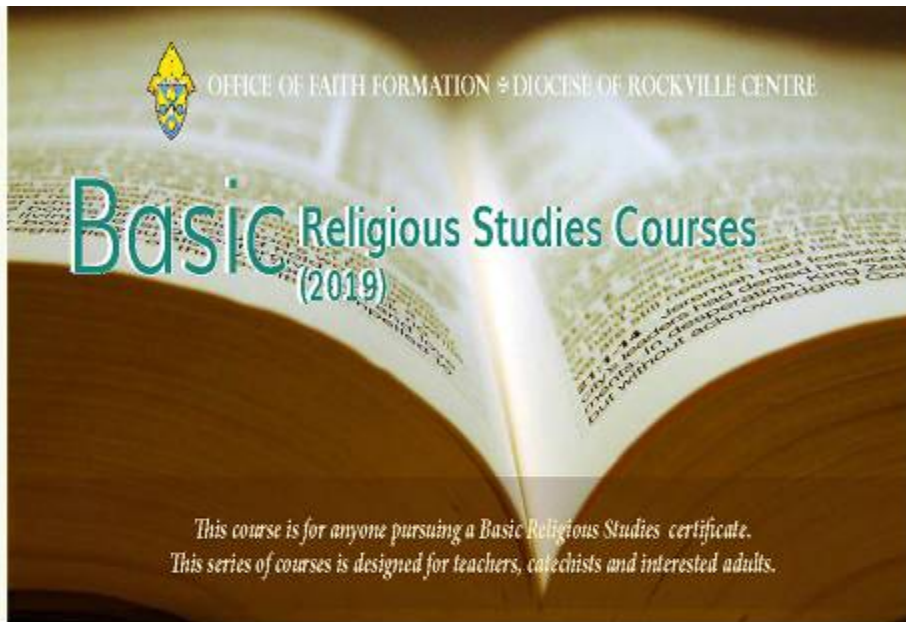
