The Bus Ride is Free

The Educational Experience is Priceless

The diocesan bus service connecting the east end with St. John the Baptist Diocesan High School makes Catholic secondary education a viable option for students from eastern Long Island.

In the early hours of the morning the cars begin to show up in the parking lot of St. Anthony's Church in Rocky Point. Parents and students chat about the day-to-come until a large yellow school bus pulls into the parking lot at 6:30 a.m. Car doors spring open as the students of St. John the Baptist Diocesan High School bid farewell to their parents and board the bus, prepared for another day of high school.

This bus, the "Red Line bus," which runs along the north shore of Suffolk County, is making the second of its three stops. Following a quick stop in Port Jefferson Station, the bus will then run as an express service directly to St. John the Baptist High School. The students, many of them former students at McGann-Mercy High School in Riverhead, have all taken the Diocese up on their offer to provide free busing from stops on eastern Long Island to West Islip's St. John the Baptist High School. By 7:30 a.m., the "Red Line" bus, along with a "Blue Line" bus from central Suffolk, and a "Green Line" bus (stops at St. Rosalie's) from Suffolk's south shore will have dropped off over 100 students from eastern Long Island to begin their day of classes.

Senior Services



We aim to ensure that seniors can live independently in comfort and safety while maintaining physical and emotional health. Social activities help seniors remain connected with the community, as well. Senior services are funded by Nassau County Office for the Aging, Suffolk County Office for the Aging, NY State Office for the Aging, the U.S. Administration on Aging, and Catholic Charities, Diocese of Rockville Centre.

Case Management

Senior case management and home care is also known as EISEP (Expanded In-home Services for the Elderly Program). This program connects Nassau County seniors with services through government agencies, parishes, and community-based organizations. A case manager works with each senior to assess needs and develop and implement a service plan, which might include home care, transportation, state and local entitlements, and other needed services.

Meals-On-Wheels

Every weekday, the Meals-On-Wheels program delivers hot, nutritious meals to the homebound in Nassau and Suffolk counties. In Nassau, seniors may also participate in the frozen meal program, which provides meals five days per week. Meals-on-Wheels case managers can assist the seniors in accessing other services they might need.

Senior Community Service Centers

Three Senior Community Service centers in Nassau County offer transportation, hot meals, recreation, entertainment, education, health services, and socialization.

Congregate Meal Sites

Three congregate meal sites in Nassau and Suffolk counties provide hot meals, socialization, and recreation for seniors and the vision impaired one to two days per week.

Eligibility and Fees

Seniors must be 60 years of age or older to participate in any senior services programs. Meals-On-Wheels are available to seniors who are homebound and unable to prepare meals. A cost share may apply to EISEP services which is determined by a case manager during the assessment process. There are small suggested donations for Meals-On-Wheels and the senior centers. No one, however, is refused these services because of an inability to pay.
