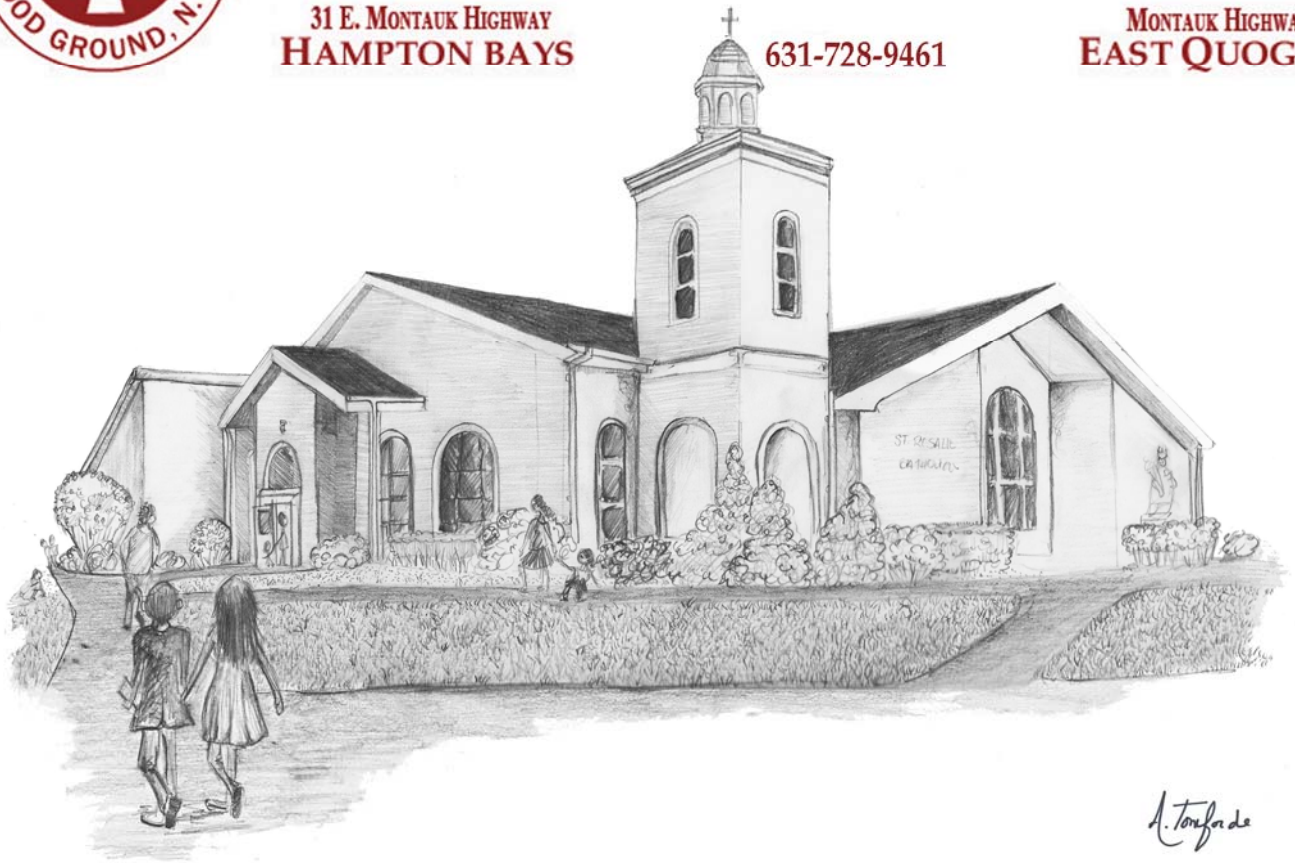

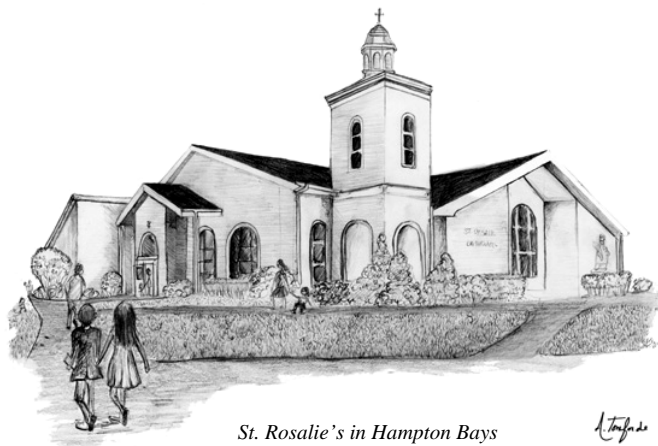

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

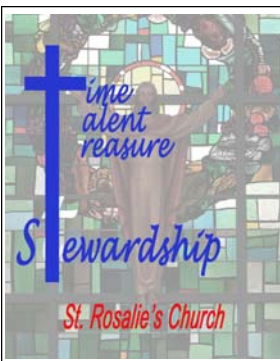
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

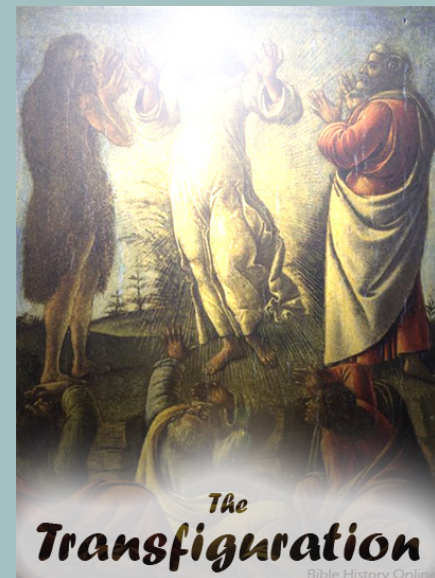
From The Pastor's Desk

The Transfiguration of the Lord

This week we hear: *Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light.* MATTHEW 17:1-2 As we go on to read in today's gospel, Peter is obviously very moved by the appearance of Elijah and Moses. Then a voice is heard: *"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."* MATTHEW 17:5

Peter asks our Lord if he can build three tents. Peter wants to remain there on that mountain, in the midst of the religious experience that he is having. Evidently he feels peace, security, tranquility: perhaps just an inkling of what heaven must be like. But Jesus reminds Peter and the disciples that there are more than just these experiences; that Jesus Himself as well as us will need to suffer as followers of Jesus Christ.

Do we allow ourselves to lose our focus, when the going gets rough? Sometimes things will be great, everything seems to go our way, but then times get difficult; someone gets ill, we may be misunderstood, or relationships are broken and in need of healing. These are just a few examples. Think, that although following Christ has its mountains, such as we hear today in the "transfiguration," there are also going to be valleys. Yes the mountains help us to get through the valleys. Christ suffered and died for us. We are called to live in a new way as disciples through our baptism. Let us choose Jesus Christ who calls us to resist temptation and to follow Him. The mountains help you get through the valleys. Most importantly follow the words of God Our Father in heaven regarding Jesus Christ His only Son: **"LISTEN TO HIM."** Let Jesus energize and help us as we journey to our own Easter!

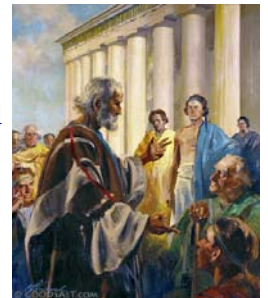

Father Robert Fath is a priest of the Diocese of Fairbanks in Alaska, the last international mission diocese in the United States. Ordained June 1, 2007 after attending Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon, Father Robert has served the sprawling diocese of northern Alaska in a number of ministries: parochial vicar of Sacred Heart Cathedral (Fairbanks), pastor of Saint Nicholas Church (North Pole), chaplain of the Catholic Schools of Fairbanks and, currently, as the Director of Vocations and Faith and Family Formation.

In addition to his pastoral responsibilities, he works as the chaplain for both the University of Alaska Fairbanks Fire Dept. and the Alaska State Troopers (D-Detachment). When he is not traveling around the diocese, Father Robert enjoys kayaking the rivers of
