The book of Nehemiah opens with the survivors of the exile feeling a great shame for their sinfulness. Their infidelity to God has allowed their enemies to triumph. 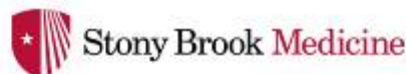
The custom-designed 40-foot van offers state-of-the-art 3D digital mammograms.
