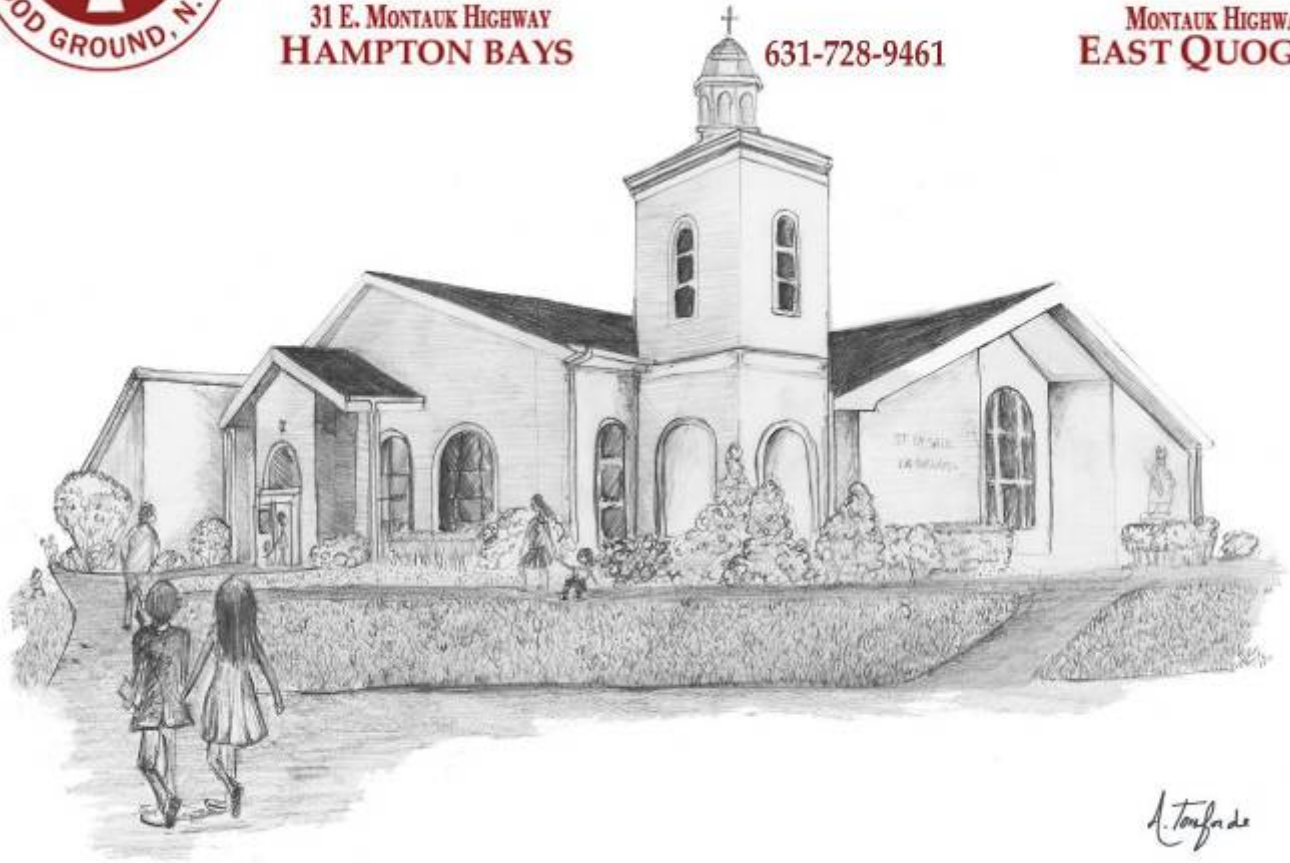

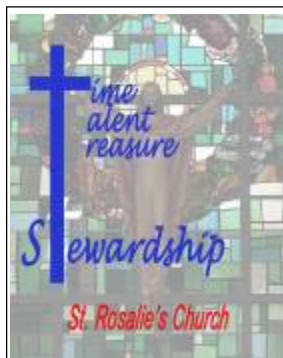

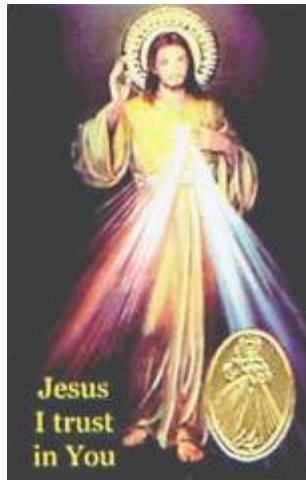

## Lord, Teach Me to Pray

Lord, Teach Me to Pray is a prayer series for women and men based on Ignatian Spirituality.

Part 1, "**Praying Christian Virtues**," helps deepen prayer life, and discover what to do for dryness and obstacles in prayer. It also introduces the different methods of Ignatian prayer, including meditation, contemplation and the Consciousness Examen. A small group will meet with trained facilitators for up to 2 hours once a week for 12 weeks to pray and faith share.

Part 2, for women, "**My 19th Annotation**" (30 weeks), consists of the entirety of the well-known "Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius," which has been adapted to accommodate contemporary prayers who cannot leave family for extended periods of time. **Note: An individual must have participated in part 1 before participating in part 2.** For further information or to register for Part 1 or Part 2, please contact Susan Lemonier at 985-502-5500.

## Many Hands Make Light Work

We need Catechists to cover some RF sessions needed to be offered so all of our young parishioners are catechized. At the time I'm preparing this article we still need a Sunday, 11 a.m. – 12:15 p.m., Level 4 catechist, and Monday, 4:30 – 5:45 p.m., Levels 1, 3 and 4 catechists. We need a catechist for a multi-level group of elementary children in grades 3-6, who will be catechized for the first time this year, on Tuesday, 4:30 – 5:45 p.m. I am also looking for some adults who are willing to be an adult in a room where the catechist is under 18 years of age. The teen catechists are trained and willing to be catechists but we need an adult with Virtus training to be the adult in the room in case of an emergency. **I am hoping that all children heading back to school, will come to the Sunday, September 1, 9:30 a.m. Mass to have their backpacks blessed!**

Would some people be available to help separate and sort the RF lesson handouts? This work will need to be done in the Parish Center within the next few weeks. It would take one person several hours, but many hands make light work, so a few people will make the project easier and faster. It is a very simple process. 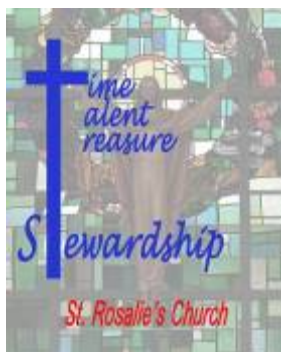
