



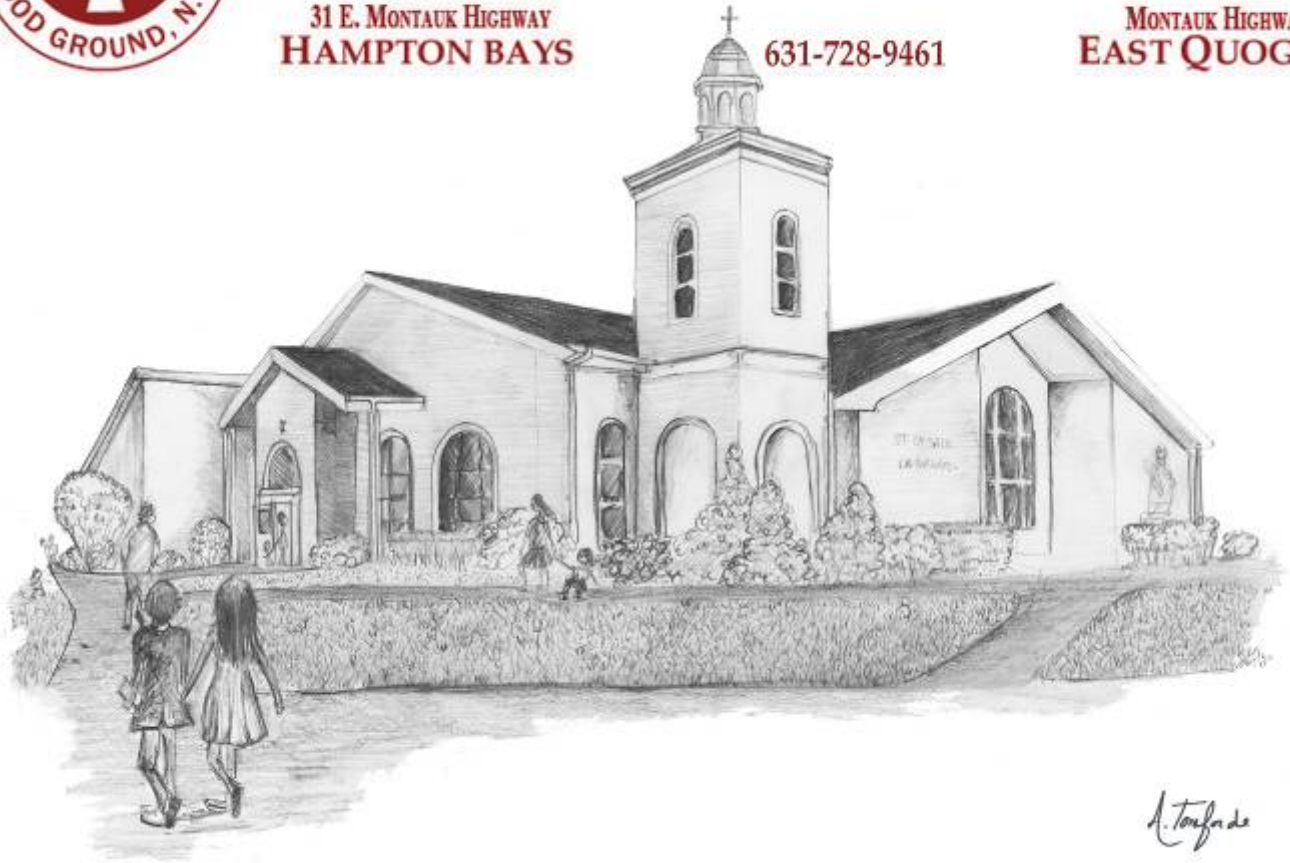

### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

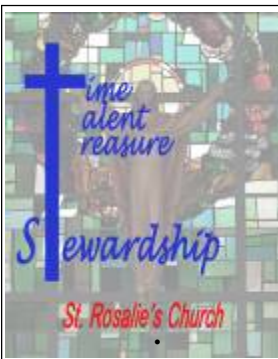
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

## From the Pastor's Desk

*Then he sat down, called the Twelve, and said to them, "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Taking a child he placed it in their midst, and putting his arms around it he said to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me." MARK 9:35-37*



These are the words from the end of today's gospel passage. Here are two things here to focus on: I think it's important for all of us to remember that Jesus did not come to be served but to serve! We are called to remember each other and to act in charitable ways to each other.

Jesus takes a child and place this child in their midst. This action highlights the fact that we all need to be like a child. A child enters the kingdom of heaven. When I think of a child at Christmas – who reacts joyfully beautifully, with wonder and awe-I think that's the image that stays with me reflecting the exuberance and the love and joy of the kingdom of God!

### St. Vincent DePaul and the Congregation of the Mission

This coming Thursday, September 27, is the Feast of St. Vincent De Paul. St Vincent founded the Congregation of the Mission (CM). St. Vincent de Paul was a priest who was born in 1581 in Puoy, France and died in Paris on this day in 1660. He has given us such a great example in serving the poor. He is venerated as a saint in both the Catholic Church and the Anglican Church. He was canonized in 1737.

We are so blessed to have priests of the Congregation of the Mission, known as Vincentians – the order that St. Vincent de Paul founded, working here at St. Rosalie's with us. Father Marvin Navas CM, Father Jesus Arellano CM, and Father Cesar Lara CM who work in our Spanish Apostolate here on the East End. I am most thankful to share our priestly ministry together in Jesus Christ here at St. Rosalie's. These Vincentian priests celebrate the 4 p.m. Mass in Spanish here at St. Rosalie's. But they also assist at six other parishes here on the East End from Riverhead to Greenport and Hampton Bays to Montauk. How blessed we are to have these good holy priests with us. If there are any young men interested in the priesthood, please stop and talk with all our priests who serve here at St. Rosalie's.

We are also very thankful for our Vincentians active on our St. Vincent DePaul Conference. They help to be the hands and feet of Christ in our parish and community. Thank you for your Vincentian spirit and service to all!

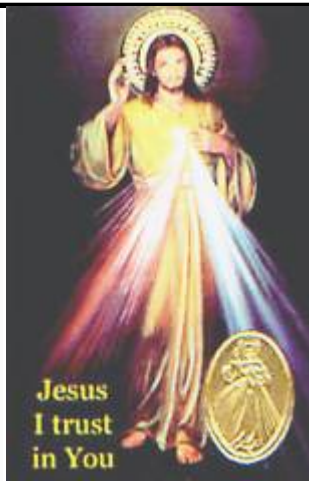

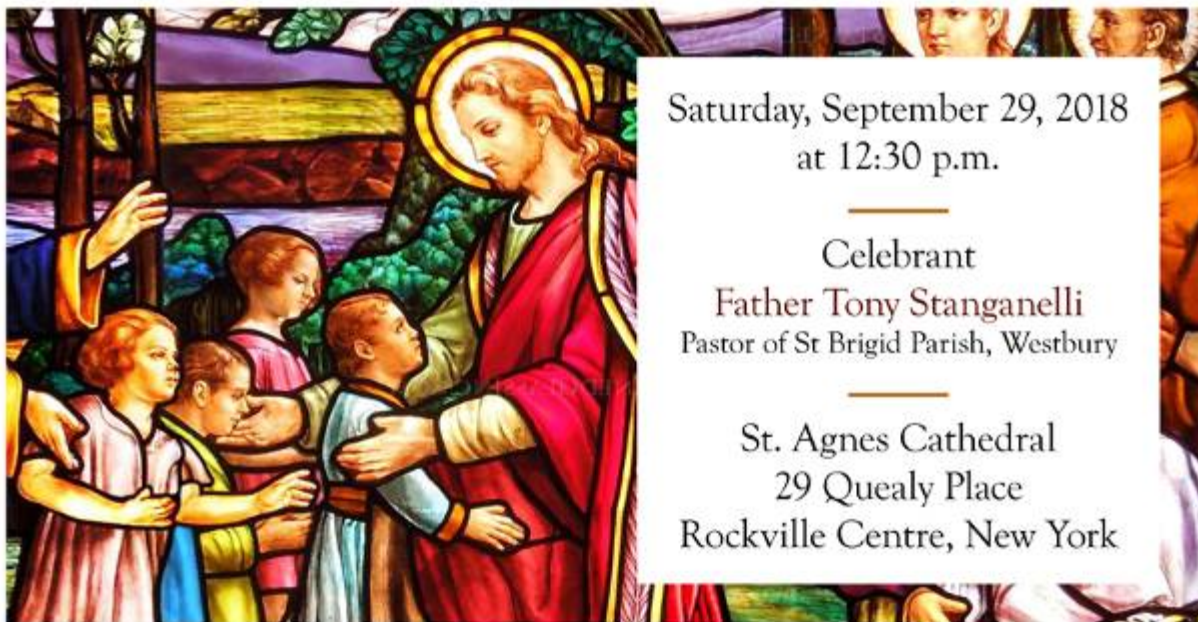
