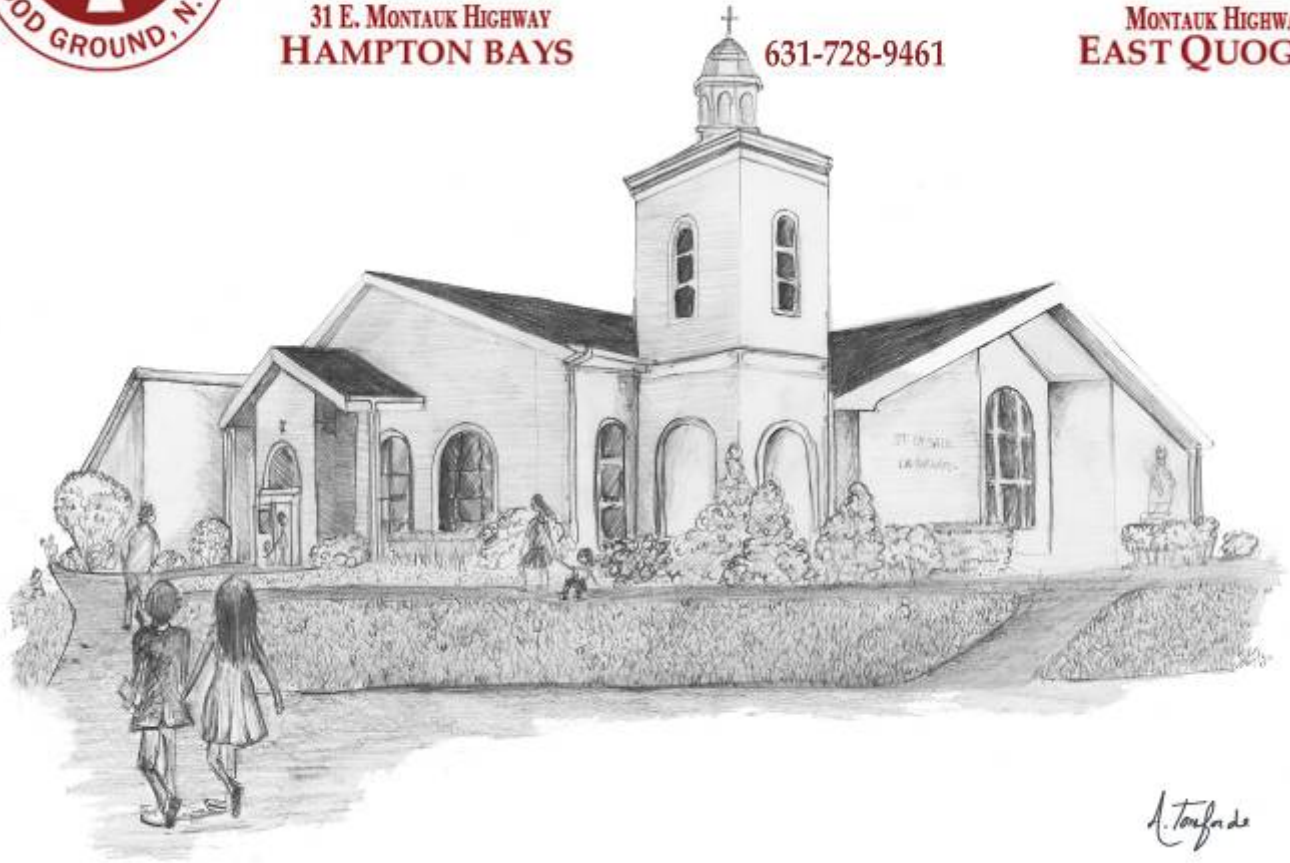

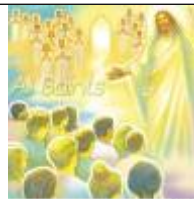

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

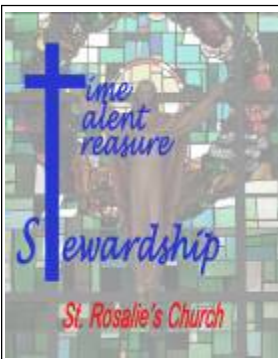
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

Father Maddaloni will be the Administrator and will be assisted by Father John and our great St Rosalie's parish Staff.

I look forward to celebrating a Farewell Parish Mass with you on Sunday, October 28 at 11 a.m., followed by a reception in the Community Center. I hope to be able to pray and speak with all of you on that day as well as on Sunday, November 11, when I will celebrate the Spanish Mass at Saint Rosalie's at 4 p.m. I hope you can join us on October 28 or November 11.

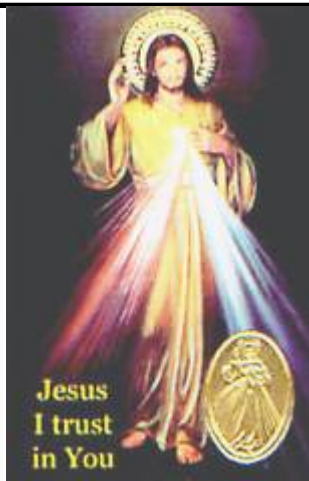

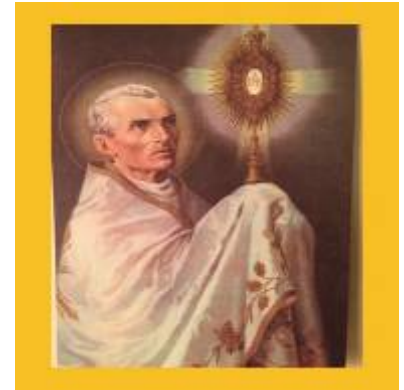
All Souls Envelopes
