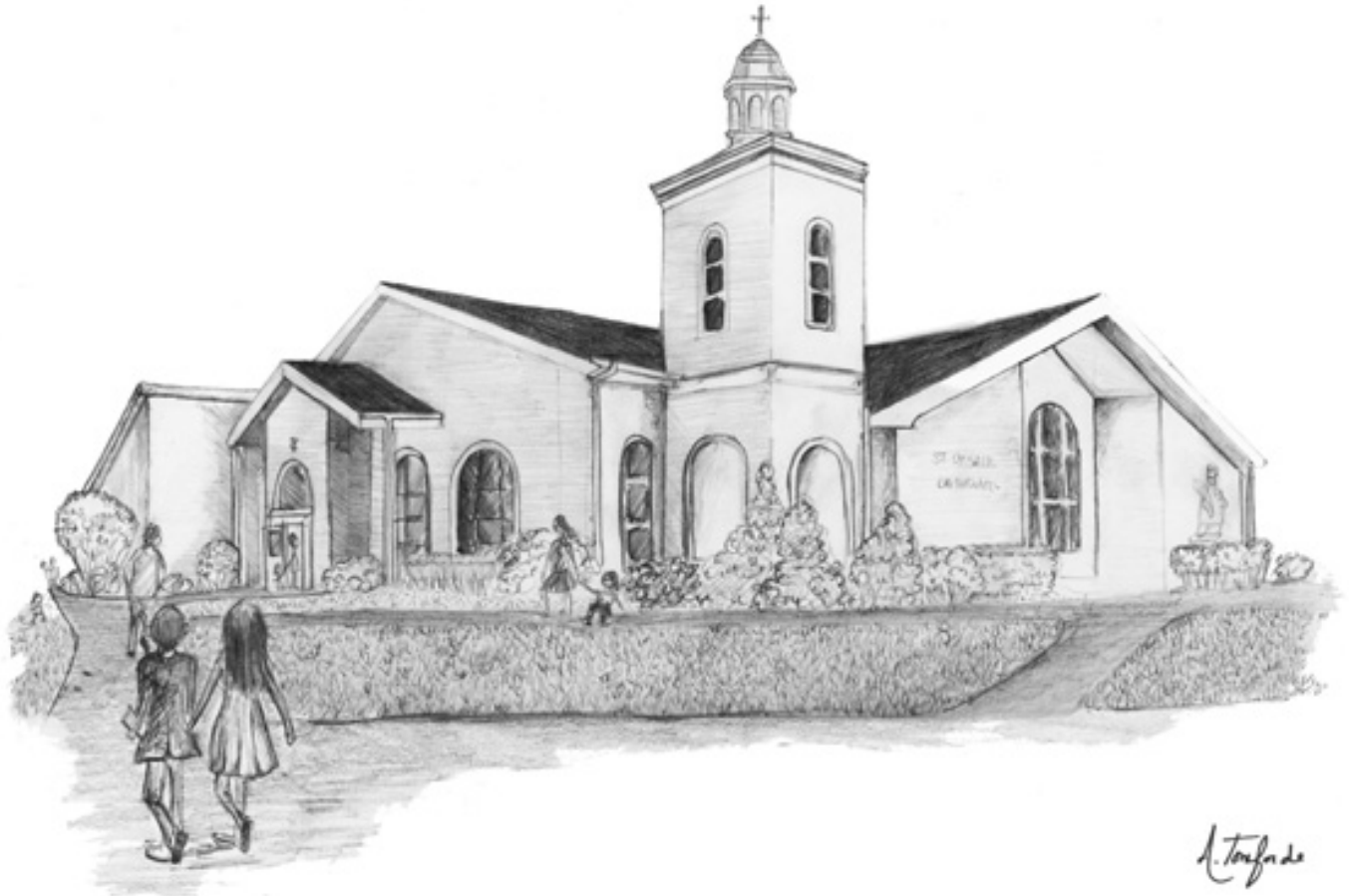

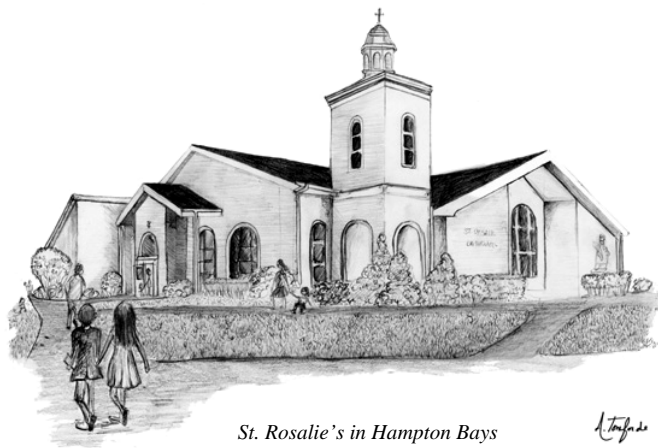

### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

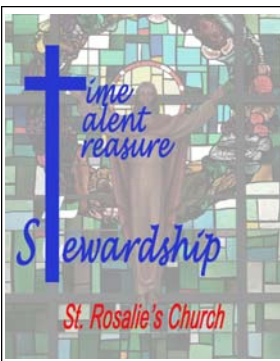
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

# From The Pastor's Desk

Lenten Journey 2015

**Lenten Regulations: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. That means anyone from their 14th birthday until age 59 in good health can have one full meal and two lighter meals, and nothing in-between meals, and can also abstain from eating meat. Lenten Fridays are days of abstinence, (we do not eat meat).**

On this first Sunday of Lent, we hear in Luke's gospel that "Jesus is led into the desert." Yes, these are the very famous temptations of Christ by the Devil. Remember, Jesus is truly Divine but He is also truly human. He is tempted, but He never enters into sin.

**The Mardi Gras party** on Tuesday February 9 was great fun! This Annual Mardi Gras party, the day before Ash Wednesday, is a nice evening with families and parishioners. Thanks to Eileen McPhelin and all her volunteers who made this Family party a huge success.

**Mite Boxes:** Perhaps you picked up a MITE Box last Sunday in preparation for Lent. MITE boxes are available, in case you didn't get one last week or on Ash Wednesday. Take a MITE box with you, one for each family. These Lenten MITE boxes are a reminder for each of us to make a Lenten commitment: A sacrifice, a positive action, an act of mercy for Lent. The Committee for the Common Good had suggested this the last two years and we had a huge response last year.

**CMA 2016:** Remember that the 2016 Catholic Ministries Appeal campaign has begun. We have such a generous response from St. Rosalie's parishioners each year. Do you realize that Deacon Chris, educated at the Immaculate Conception Seminary and serving as a Deacon here at St Rosalie's since his ordination, is a beneficiary of the CMA appeal? Deacon Chris will be an ordained Deacon for 12 years on May 22. He received his diaconal formation at Immaculate Conception Seminary in Huntington, as well as his on-going education. The word "diakonia" in Greek means to serve. All of us in embracing CMA serve the needs of others in our midst! Thanks for your generosity! 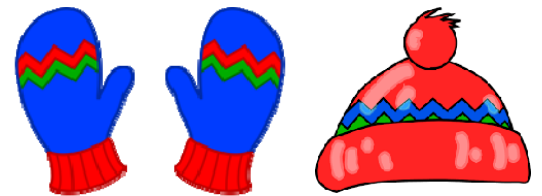

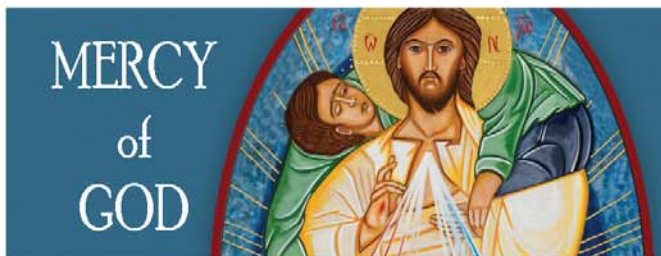

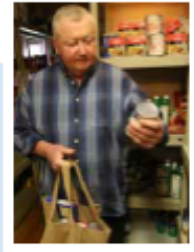

**Ayuno, Abstinencia y Actos de Penitencia para la Cuaresma:** Los obispos de los Estados Unidos prescriben, como obligación mínima, que todas las personas que han cumplido los catorce años y los mayores de catorce están obligadas a abstenerse de comer carne todos los viernes de cuaresma. Además, todas las personas desde los dieciocho años de edad hasta los cincuenta y nueve años, inclusivos, están obligadas a ayunar limitándose a una sola comida completa el viernes santo, mientras las otras dos comidas en esos días deben ser ligeras.

A todos los fieles se les anima, cuando sea posible, a participar en la Misa y recibir la santa comunión; a celebrar con frecuencia el sacramento de la penitencia; a iniciar lecturas espirituales, especialmente el estudio de las Sagradas Escrituras; y a participar en las devociones de cuaresma, así como en programas cuaresmales de educación.
