



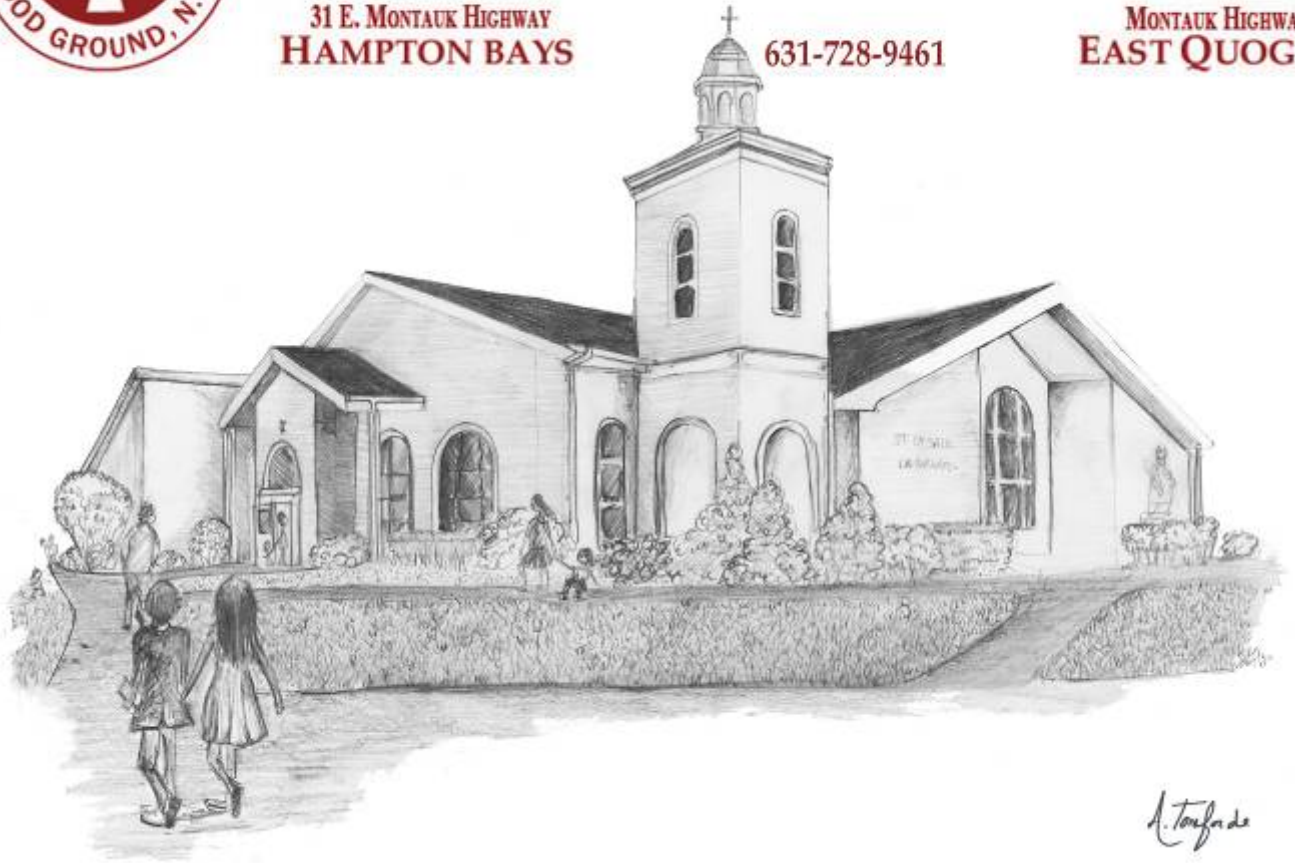

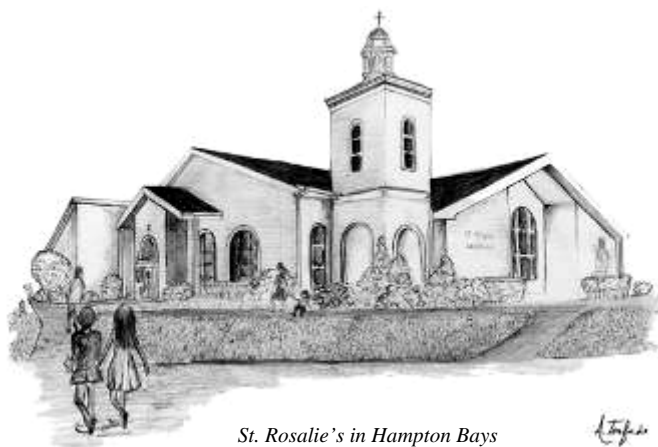

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

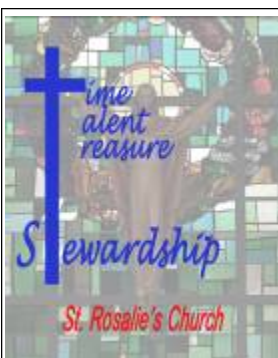
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

From The Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, on the Seventh Sunday of Easter, which falls on Memorial Day Weekend, we hear in the Gospel:

"I revealed your name to those whom you gave me out of the world. They belonged to you, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything you gave me is from you, because the words you gave to me I have given to them, and they accepted them and truly understood that I came from you, and they have believed that you sent me. I pray for them." JOHN 17:7-9

Here we learn the beautiful connection between Father and Son. This is what Jesus' public ministry was about – the revelation to the disciples and to all of us about the intimacy of the relationship between the heavenly Father and Jesus Christ, the Son of God. Now the disciples know that everything good comes from God, and they have accepted the fact that Jesus gave them the words and the gifts that come from God – and they, the disciples, recognize that they too are from God. 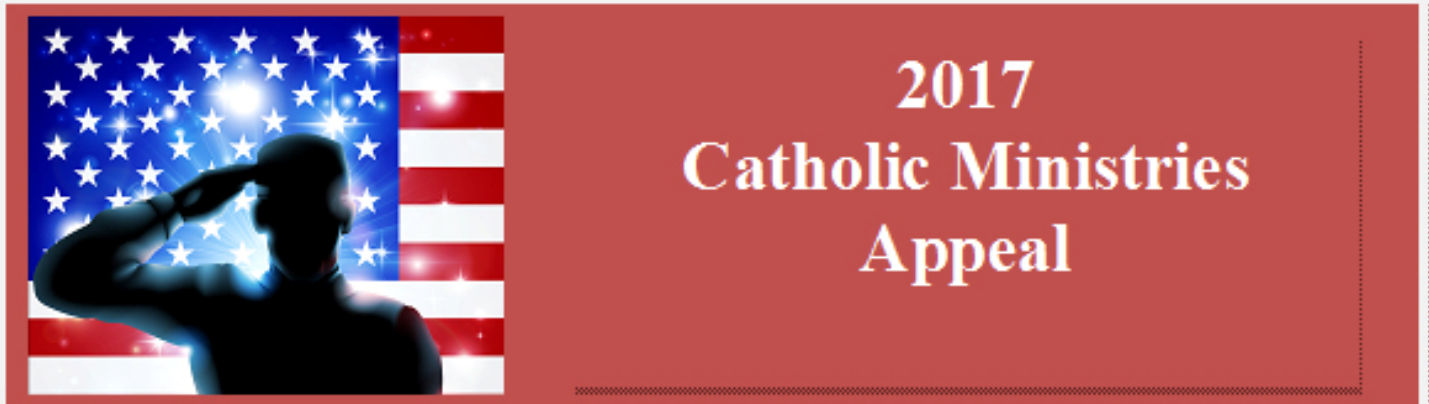
