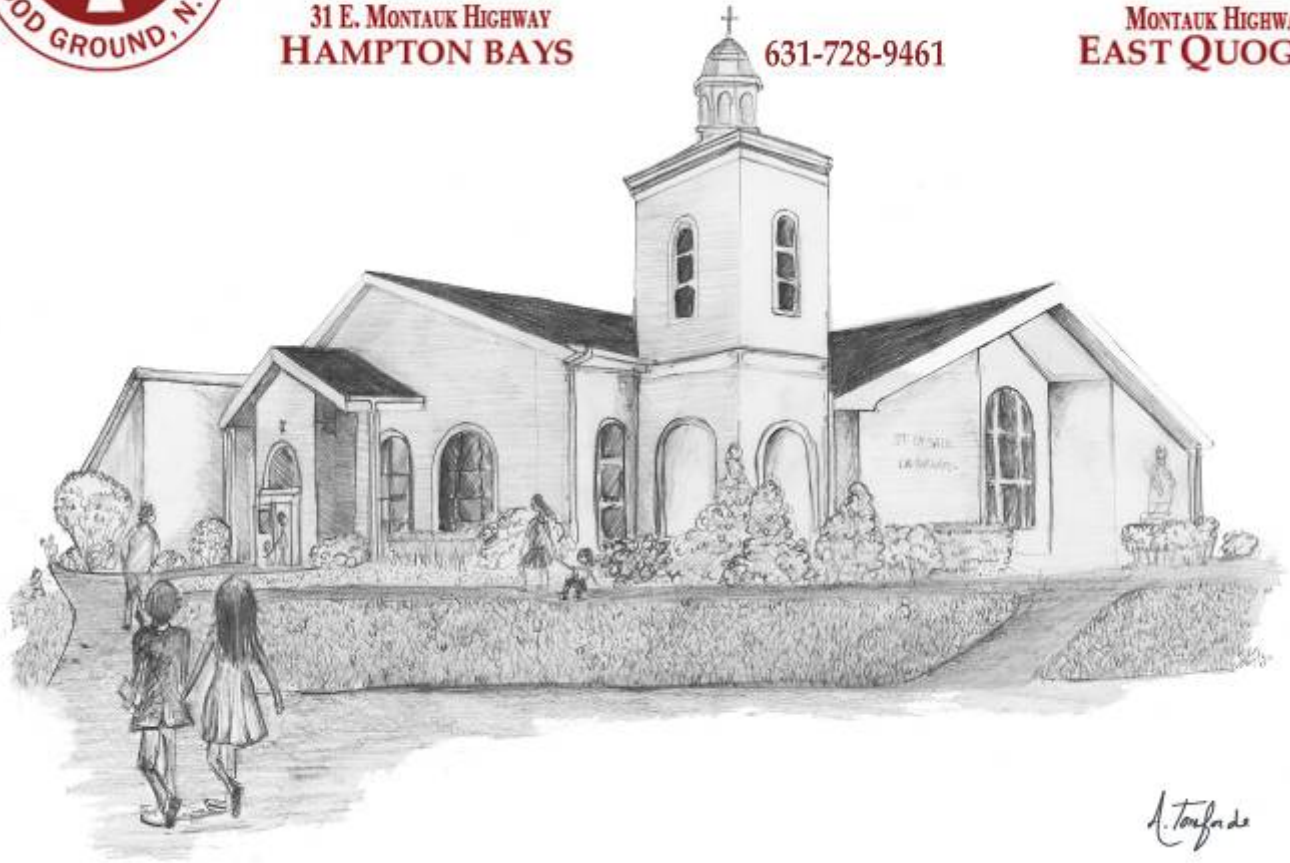

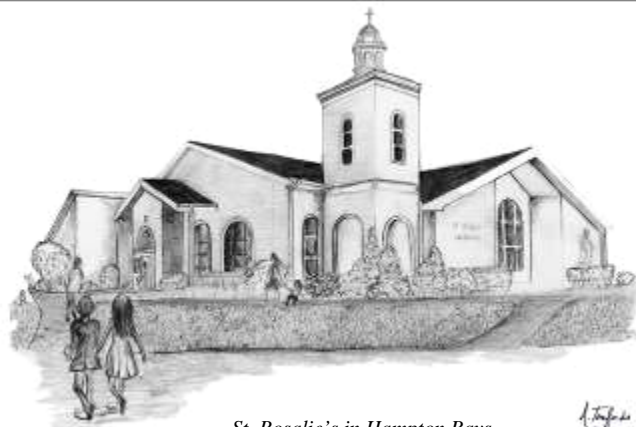

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

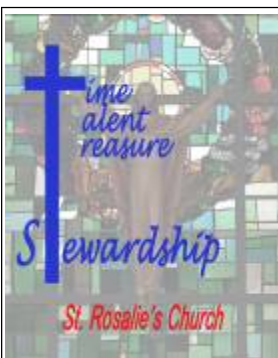
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Last Sunday, we celebrated the great Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ and I spoke of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Today, I would like to focus on Christ's sacrifice, which we celebrate every time we celebrate Mass. When Mass is celebrated it is certainly the "re-presentation" of Christ's sacrifice. Christ offers the sacrifice and we, as "fully conscious participants," become united with the sacrifice of Christ. Christ offered Himself on the Cross. That's what we re-present every time Mass is celebrated. Christ died on the Cross and then rose from the dead by the power of God the Father. Over the years at the memorial acclamation we said: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again." But as I mentioned last Sunday, we need to keep all three elements of Sacrifice, Communion and Real Presence in mind. It is all three which help us have the fullest understanding of the celebration of the Eucharist. We are invited at Mass: **The Body of Christ**. We respond: **Amen**, Yes Lord, I Believe. Thank you/ Gracias. Next week, we will continue to talk about the Eucharist with the third element-Communion.

CMA

Our parish is climbing closer to our goal, but not yet at the Catholic Ministries Appeal Goal of \$81,500. Currently we are at a pledge level of \$55,890. There are currently 189 donors. I want to thank all those who have made a CMA pledge. I plan to make my Catholic Ministries Appeal Pledge this month. I do ask everyone to consider making a pledge. It does go a long way. Did you know that our Seminarians who have been in our parish over the years like Michael Plona and Jeff Yildermaz who spent time here in past summers, are now ordained priests in our diocese? Also, Matthew Browne who was with us the last two summers will be ordained a Deacon in November and a priest God-willing in June of 2019. When we make our goal we as a parish will get a large rebate from the Appeal. The great news is that all pledges over our goal will now come back to the parish directly in a significant rebate. Please, if you have not yet pledged, you can make a big difference! A few years ago we received as much as \$36,000 in rebates, and I believe we can match that again. These funds will be used directly for our Parish Social Ministry to help fund our local Food Pantry, our all-important youth programs and summer parish retreat, just to name a few. How responsive all of you are. I am truly blessed to be your pastor. I thank you on behalf of all we serve here together at St. Rosalie's: the poor, the young, those growing older, the hungry and those in need. May God shower you with His blessings for all that you do and all that you are – the hands and feet of Jesus Christ!
