



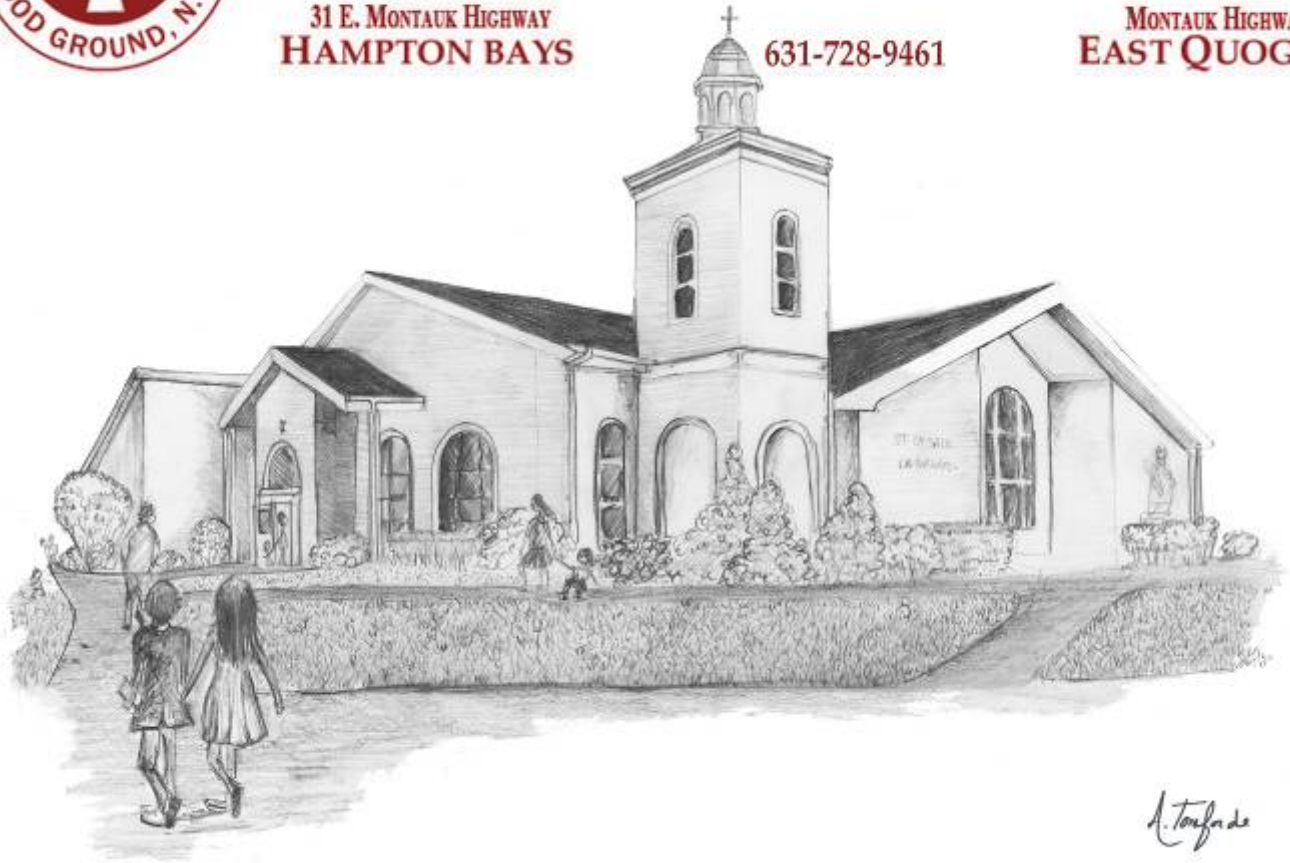

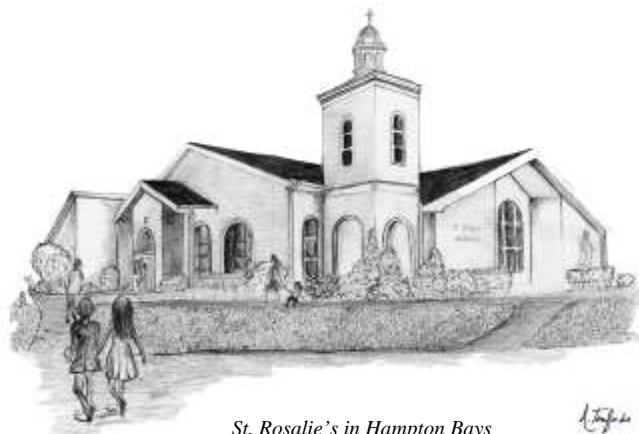

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

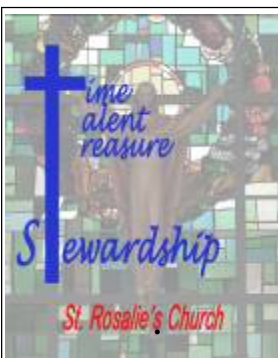
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the desert, but they died; this is the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.” JOHN 6:48-51



It is in John's Gospel where we have this Bread of Life Discourse. In the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke) there are what we call institution narratives, where we hear the words that Jesus spoke at the Last Supper. I truly love the poetic aspect of St. John's Gospel. The beautiful Bread of Life Discourse which was proclaimed in today's Gospel speaks of the "Bread of Life come down from heaven." 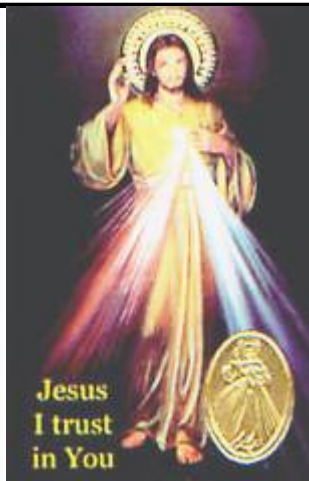

Religious Formation

GETTING CLOSER

As summer draws closer to its end, we, in the RF office, focus on the upcoming RF sessions for our young parishioners. It is through the faith knowledge they gain that we hope they draw closer to the Holy Trinity and come to recognize the graces and gifts of what being Catholic offers to us.

We offer programs for children in grades one through 12. For most children, after level one, they continue to register each year to continue learning until the time of Confirmation, at the high school age. There are other programs offered for those who have not started in grade one or have left the program for awhile. We are here to offer what is needed to help our young parishioners be more prepared for life's situations at any age using our Catholic faith, trust and hope.

The registration forms will be available in the RF office in the Parish Center and online through our parish website as of August 20. All registrations must have three forms: one with Family information, one for the Child's information and one for the "sign-off" for the parent information handbook.

There are a few additional, new programs and features for the 2018-19 term. We will offer an **At Home** program for the parents and guardians with children entering kindergarten this September. The lessons will be done at home and a few times per year the parents and children will come together with the director, Ms. Eileen C. McPhelin, to discuss and share what was offered.

The other new feature is a mandated safety program, from our diocese, for the parents and children who are in levels one to six. Our diocese offers all it can to help our families understand the unsafe methods that can draw children away from God or put them in harm's way. The name of the program is "Child Safety Lures." It has been used for some years in other dioceses and is now to be implemented in our diocese's parishes. It is a program that offers a way to help children recognize what can harm them, physically, mentally and emotionally, in language that will not upset a child. It will help them connect that they are children of God and no one has a right to harm them, as they have the right to stop what is dangerous to them – at every age.

If you know of a child aged 6 - 17, who has not received their Sacraments, who does not have a Catholic adult in their life to guide them – please be the one to help them toward living a life that God wants for them. Talk to them, give them my name and contact info. We are all here to help each other get to heaven. Thank you for your support and prayers for our office staff, and our young families.

St. Vincent de Paul Reflection

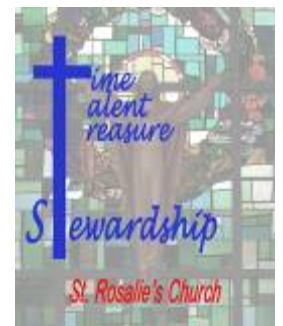
