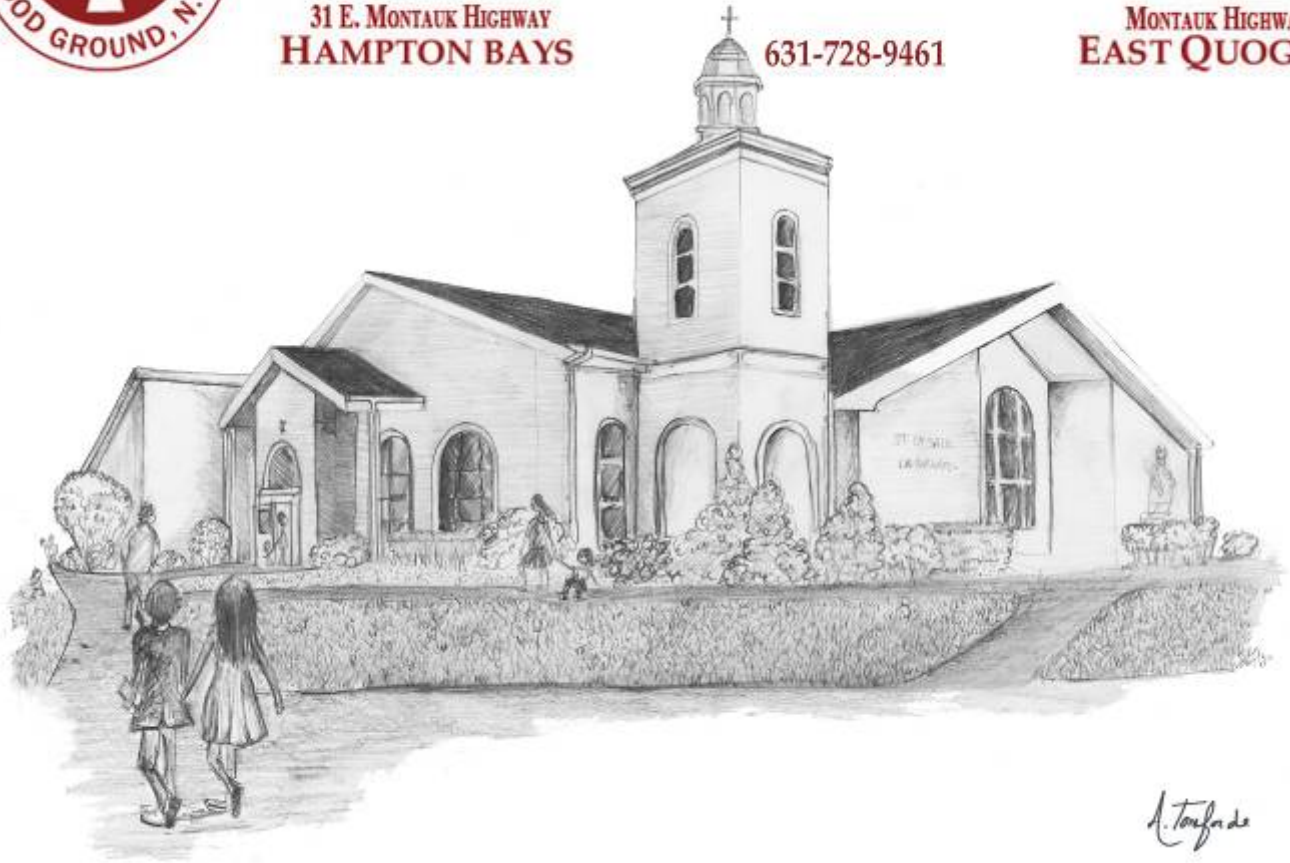

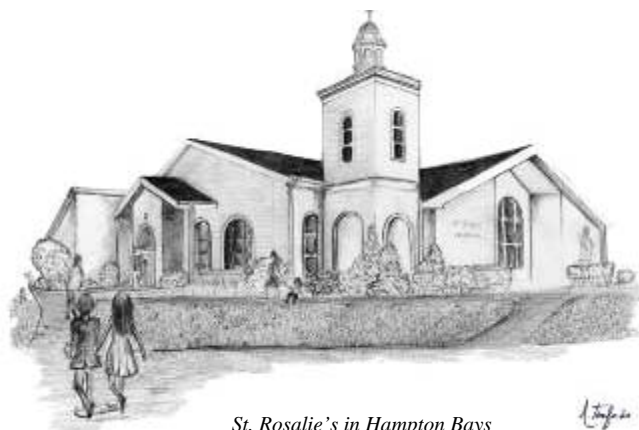

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

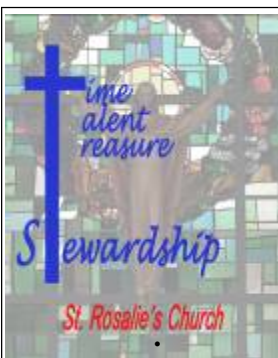
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,
In today's Gospel we hear:

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us [his] flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. 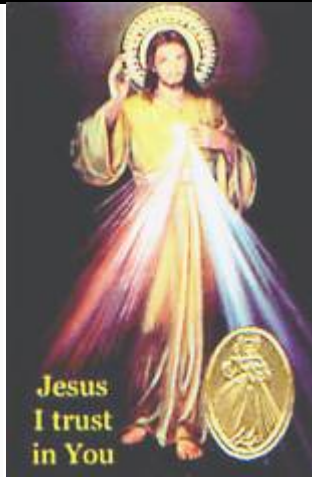

Religious Formation

Registration for the 2018-2019 Religious Formation programs will start on August 20. Completed registration forms are required for every child in all programs. The forms will be available in the Parish Center RF office or online from the website. **There are 3 forms needed for each child:**



1. Parent or family information,
2. Child's information,
3. Parent or guardian's sign-off form to agree they received the required Parent Guidelines Information.

Forms are in English and Spanish.

PROGRAMS AVAILABLE

Level 1 for children enrolling for the first time who are in either first or second grade.

Level 2 for the children who were enrolled in and completed Level 1 last year.

Levels 3-6 for children in grades 3-6 who were enrolled and completed the program last year.

Levels C1 and C2 for teens in grades 7 and 8 who have completed the necessary basic formation lessons through level 6.

Level C3 for teens who are in the final preparation to receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the fall of 2019.

RCIA-Teen: a program for teens in grades 10 – 12 who have not received sacraments beyond Baptism.

CUC introduction to the Catholic faith for children in grades 3 – 7 who are enrolling for the first time or have had a lapse of years of continuing formation.

All RF sessions are led by catechists who have been trained and are committed to helping our parish children and their parents have the “tools” needed to live a life on earth that will guide them, with the teachings of the Catholic Church, to better understand God's need of their assistance in bringing peace on earth, starting within the family.

We are in need of 7 catechists for the 2018-19 RF sessions. Please contact Ms. Eileen McPhelin if you are interested for further information. Consider the availability of either couples or friends becoming “team-catechists.” It's a way of becoming a catechist with less time commitment.
