



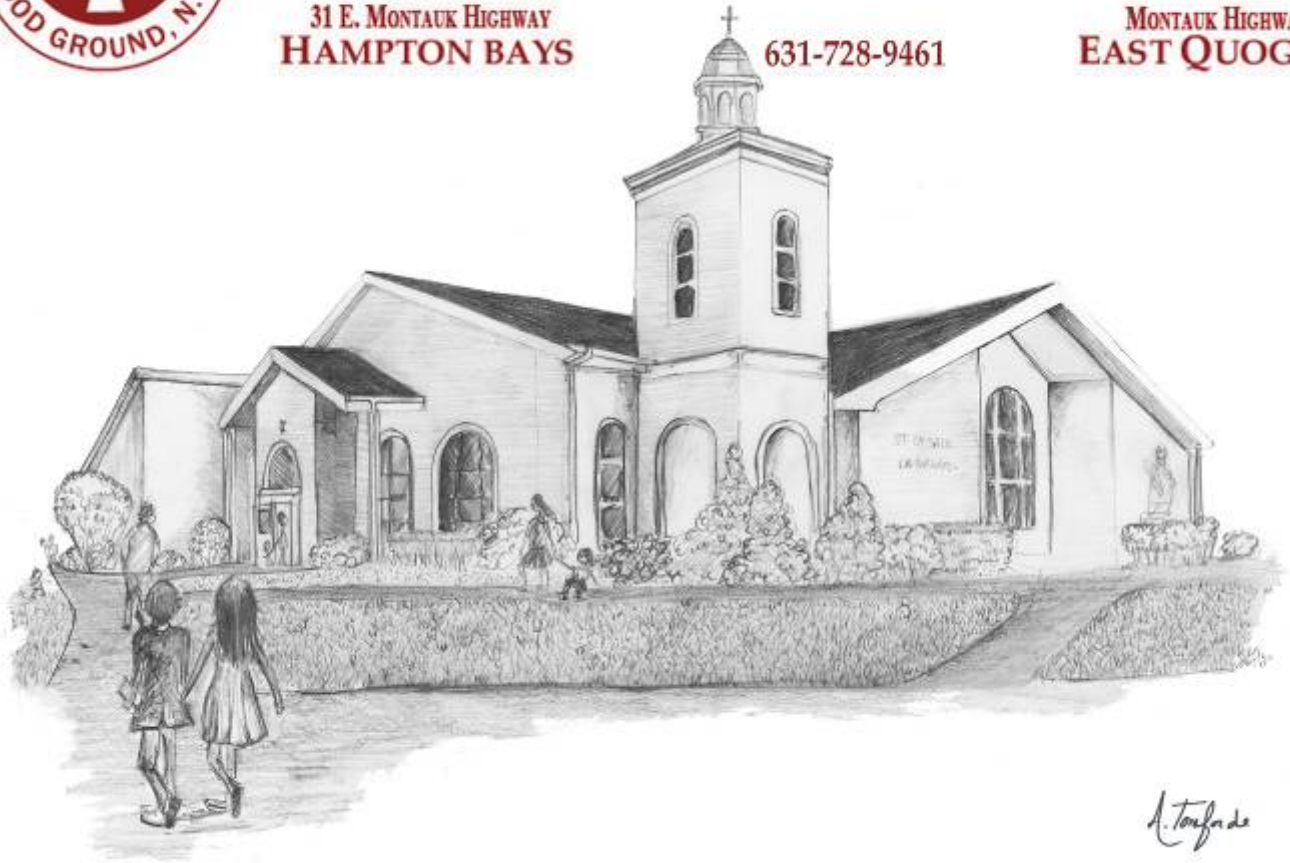

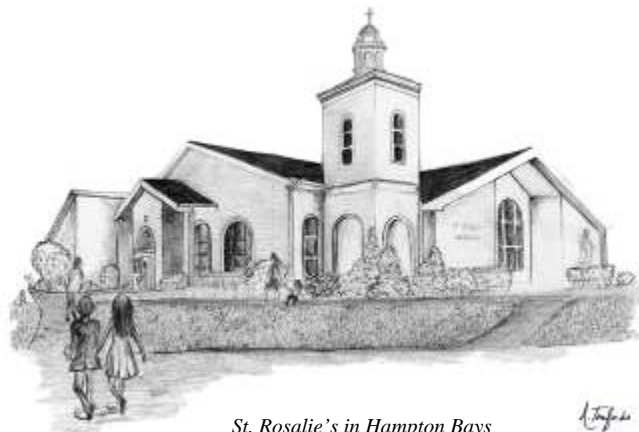

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

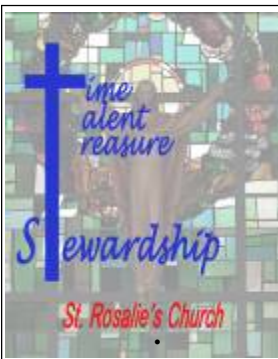
Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4–4:30 p.m. or by appointment.

From the Desk of Father Maddaloni

Mark 7:35 – “...*the man's ears were opened...and he spoke plainly.*”

The man of Decapolis cannot speak clearly until he hears well. Upon curing him, Jesus orders the people not to spread the news of this miracle around. He does not want his ministry to be defined by miracles alone.

Yet, his miracles do matter. They are signs pointing to the greatness of God embodied in the person of Jesus. The outward physical miracles that Jesus performs say something to us about the interior spiritual life.

There is, in fact, a connection between good hearing and good articulation. Like the man of Decapolis, we, too, must first hear clearly before we can articulate well. We Christians share a common mission – to hear the Word of God and to articulate the Word to the world. Are our ears open to hear the Christian message? Throughout the Gospels, Jesus speaks it to us in all that he says and does. The key to Christian living is love. Jesus speaks the Christian message by word and deed to Jews and pagans, to pillars of society and public sinners, to the powerful and the weak.

In his letter, St. James is concerned about how Christians are articulating the Christian message. He urges us to practice blind love, love that reaches past dividing lines. In his example, the dividing line is socio-economic. We can think of so many more ways to divide. These dividing lines can get in the way of our articulation of the Word. That is a problem for our mission.

It is important for us to take the time to listen to God, to hear God, to recall the message that Jesus spoke to so many. Do we articulate it clearly? With our words? Our deeds? Our attitudes?

Do we articulate it consistently all the time?

I pray for God's help with this. I hope I am getting better.
