



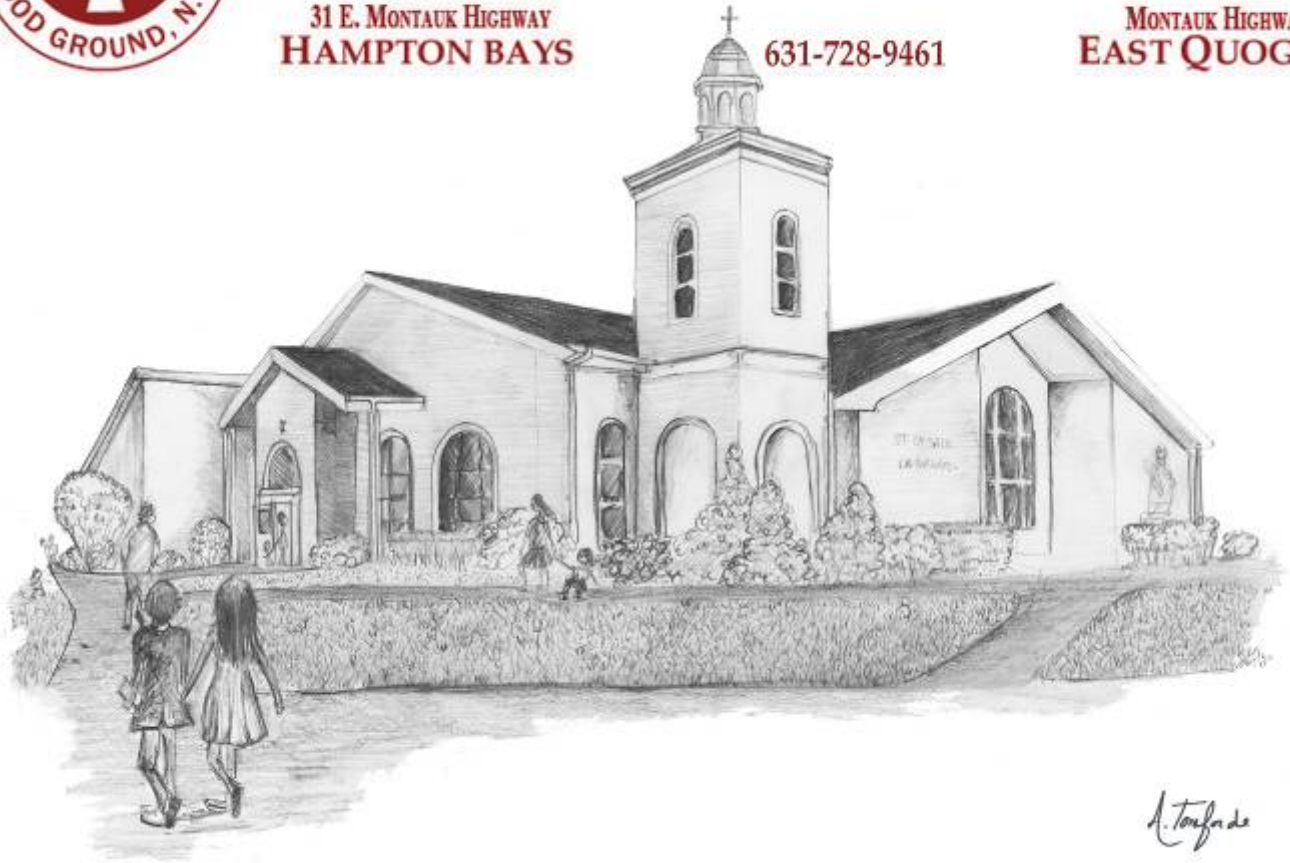

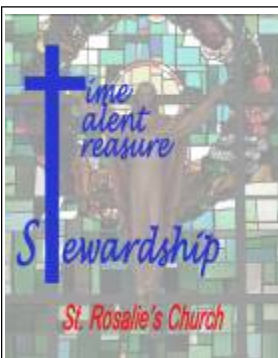

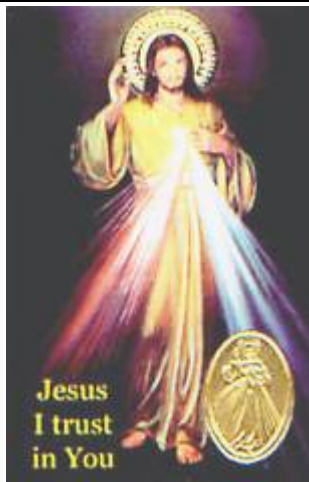

The Holy Day will be celebrated in East Quogue on Thursday, August 15, at 7:30 p.m.



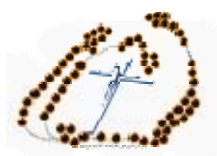

## Registration for 2019-2020 Religious Formation

Registration will begin August 19

All students who were enrolled in Levels 1–6, C1, C2 and CUC sessions should register for the upcoming sessions. There is a maximum of 16 students per room to be able to best suit the needs of our young parishioners and the catechists. We have a first-come, first-served policy. Please be aware that Monday sessions usually fill up first.

Sessions available to those in levels 1–6 (usually students who are in first-sixth grades) will enroll for once-a-week sessions offered on Sunday at 11 a.m.–12:15 p.m. or Monday or Tuesday sessions offered at 4:30–5:45 p.m. These sessions will be held in the Parish Center.

Students in upper levels, C1 and C2 (usually those in seventh and eighth grades) will enroll for sessions to be held on alternate Tuesday evenings, 7–8:30 p.m. in the Parish Center.

Students who completed sessions including C2 will enroll in Level C3, which meets on Monday evenings, 7:15–8:45 p.m. in the Community Center.

Students who have not enrolled in RF sessions and are in grade two or higher, will be evaluated at the time of registration to determine the appropriate program for each individual.

Students in Grades 10–12 who require Sacraments will need to make an appointment with Ms. Eileen McPhelin to determine the appropriate program for registration.

Any child aged seven and above will need one year of formal RF lessons before final preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism. Sacraments following Baptism will take place after continuing required RF lessons are completed.

Our goal is to provide each child with God's graces bestowed on them from the Sacraments, after the child has been properly prepared to receive those Sacraments.

The priority for each Catholic is to attend weekly Mass. Children who enroll in RF sessions will only be allowed to continue if they adhere to this priority. RF sessions are to assist in learning what it means to be Catholic. The lessons can never take the place of, or be of, higher importance than attending weekly and Holy Day Masses.

Registration forms and needed information can be found in the Parish Center. The RF office is open Monday-Thursday, 9 a.m.–4 p.m. It will also be open on Monday evenings until 7 p.m. during Registration time. First time registrants will need to bring a Birth Certificate and a Baptism Certificate (if the child has been baptized).

### The Bus Ride is Free The Educational Experience is Priceless

**The diocesan bus service connecting the east end with St. John the Baptist Diocesan High School makes Catholic secondary education a viable option for students from eastern Long Island.**

Pick up and drop off points for students are at Diocesan properties such as churches and elementary schools. One of the most unique elements of the Diocesan bus service are a group of people out of the local communities who act as "Site Coordinators." A Site Coordinator is an adult from the parish or parent community who is at the bus stop for each departure and arrival. "Site Coordinators are Virtus-trained individuals who have access to the buildings at each stop to make sure that shelter and rest room facilities are available to the students," said Gary Layton, who coordinates the bus program for the Diocese. "They are in place to assure the safety and security of the locations we use, and to make sure that no student ever gets left behind because their ride home was delayed."

"The most important thing the bus program does is it assures parents selecting a Catholic Education that there is a complete path from Nursery through 12th grade available to families," stated Mr. Layton. "A Catholic education is truly a gift for the children who use the schools," he continued. "Our students overachieve academically, but more importantly, they are learning and living their faith every day, making them kind and compassionate people. As the coordinator of the program, and a school parent myself, that is what matters most to me."
